Dear Friends in Christ,


I wanted to share a few thoughts with you this week as I continue my stay at Villa St. Joseph and keep St. Christopher's very much on my mind. Being here has slowed my days down in ways I didn't expect, and it's given me time to reflect and to notice things I usually rush past.

That actually lines up nicely with this Sunday's Gospel. When Jesus stands up and says that the words of Isaiah are being fulfilled right then and there, it's a reminder that God doesn't wait for perfect conditions. God shows up in real time, in real life — even when things don't look the way we planned.

I feel that pretty clearly while I'm here at the Villa. This wasn't where I expected to be, but it's become a place where I'm learning to accept where I am for now. And St. Paul's image of us as one body feels especially true — even from here, I'm very aware of how connected we all are.

Staying connected during the week matters, and one small way to do that is through our parish Formed subscription. If you follow St. Christopher's on Facebook or Instagram, you'll see a post every Sunday at 11:00 a.m. pointing you to something worth checking out.
