— SACRAMENTS —

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered on Sundays at 1:00 pm. First time parents must attend a Baptism preparation program. Godparents are also welcome to attend this class. Please call the parish office to arrange for the baptism of your child and to register for the class.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is ordinarily administered on Saturdays after the 8:00 am Mass and again from 3:45 to 4:30 pm.

Sacraments of the Sick are administered upon request. Please call the parish office to arrange for Holy Communion to be brought on Sunday mornings to those either temporarily or permanently housebound. If preferred, a family member can be designated to do this. We want all of our housebound members to have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion every Sunday.

The Sacrament of Marriage must be arranged six months ahead of time. One of the couple must be a member of the parish. The times for Saturday weddings are 10:00 am, 12:00 & 2:00 pm. Friday evening weddings can also be arranged.

Eucharistic Adoration: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, in our Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Entrance to the chapel is the second door to the left of our school's main entrance. You will need to key in the code number followed by the star. Please contact the parish office for the code number. For the sake of security, we are refraining putting the code number in written form.

Holy Communion: We have very low gluten hosts available for any parishioner who needs them. Please come to the sacristy prior to the Mass and let the priest know you require a low gluten host. These hosts are approved by the Celiac Society.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

On March 3rd, we celebrated the feast day of St. Katharine Drexel. As you probably know, Katharine was a Philadelphian who came from a very wealthy family. From the time she was young, she was also a deeply faith-filled person.

As a young woman, she had the opportunity to travel to Rome, where she was granted a private audience with Pope Leo XIII. At the time, missionaries were being sent to the United States to serve immigrant populations. Katharine asked the Holy Father if he could also send missionaries to serve African Americans and Native Americans. The Pope looked at her and said, "Why don't you become a missionary yourself?" Those words stayed with her and, in time, she decided to do exactly what he suggested. A window in the rear of our church, although not historically accurate, depicts this moment in Saint Katherine's life.

Founding a religious congregation is no small task. It takes a lot of work and a lot of patience. Katharine even entered the Sisters of Mercy so she could experience religious life herself and be better prepared to welcome women into a new community. She looked to places like Ireland, where vocations were plentiful (which sounds a little hard to imagine today!). Many sisters joined her and came to serve in what we now call the "home missions." She named the new community the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament.

Saints' feast days are usually (though not always) the date of their death—their "birthday" into heaven. Our other Philadelphia saint, St. John Neumann, is celebrated on January 5th, the anniversary of his death. St. Katharine's body is in our Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul. If you're ever in Center City, it's well worth stopping in to visit her shrine. St. John Neumann's body is at St. Peter's Church at Fifth and Girard Streets in Philadelphia.

This past Wednesday, our little ones had their first confessions. I was so happy to be able to be with them and to encourage them to turn to the Lord whenever they need His Presence. As you know, I have not regularly been back at the parish, but I am determined to be present for special things like the first confessions of the children. I will also be present for the sacrament of confirmation which will be administered by Archbishop James Green, who is a retired Vatican diplomat and who is also a very good friend of mine.

It is my prayer that our Lenten journey will bring us closer to the Lord.
