Where's Alex??

We've had some prayerful fun this past year as we've followed the path and ministry of Alex Medoff, our native son, who was leader of NET Team Four the past year. The National Evangelization Teams are one of many responses to the needs of our culture and our faith. In a time when it seems many people aren't even attending Mass regularly, it's heartening to hear about young people taking time out of their lives to share their faith and invite others to that relationship with Christ that will be our ultimate fulfillment.

Where's Alex now?

Well, he's finished his service in NET Ministries and is back home. If you're an attendee at the 6 PM Sunday Mass, you may have seen/heard him at the cantor's stand as he's returning to that ministry while also helping out as part of the Core Team for our parish Youth Ministry.

Where's Alex going?

I take great pleasure to inform you that Alex has been accepted to St. Charles Seminary to begin formation and continue discernment for the priesthood in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Since Alex already has his college degree, he will begin his formation in the Spirituality Year Program and continue with two years of Pre-Theology to prepare for graduate theology studies (4 years). Alex joins John McCabe, our other native son, in formation and discernment. We offer both of them our continuing prayers and support as they work, study and pray to discern where God is calling them in their lives.

Ultimately, vocation is about happiness. Where is God calling me in this life to both serve Him and also be happy in that service? Did any of you marry your spouse because you thought he/she would make you miserable? Did you get married because you thought marriage itself was some sort of penance you had to undergo to get into heaven? If so, WE NEED TO TALK O!! God wants us to be happy. Smiling every moment of the day, maybe not, but at heart, happy. The challenge of the priesthood and religious life, I think, is that so many people look at the particular sacrifices of those vocations (there are no sacrifices in marriage, right? And yes, that was sarcasm!) and don't see those vocations as sources of happiness. But if that's where God happens to be calling, that's where the happiness will be.

How to get to that happiness?

Openness. Openness to God's love; openness to God's invitation to follow Him whatever the vocation may be. Alex and John have been open to the possibility of God's call to the priesthood and our prayer for them and for all our parishioners is that we stay open to wherever God may be calling us. He's calling us to something happy. He's calling us to something great.


SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME July 17, 2022

First Reading: Genesis 18:1-10a

The Lord appeared to Abraham, who saw three men standing near his tent. Sensing they were messengers, he hurriedly brought them food and water to refresh themselves. Upon leaving, the men told him that they would visit in a year, at which time his childless wife Sarah would have a son.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:24-28

Paul discusses the suffering Christ endured for his Church. He describes his willingness to also endure suffering in Jesus' name. Paul hopes that through his sacrifices, many people will become complete in Jesus.



Gospel: Luke 10:38-42

Jesus was welcomed into the home of a woman named Martha. She complained to Jesus that her sister Mary sat listening to him instead of helping with the tasks of entertaining. Jesus told Martha that her sister had chosen the more important task, and should be allowed to listen.



HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ on behalf of his body, which is the church, of which I am a minister, in accordance with God's stewardship given to me to bring to completion for you the word of God, the mystery hidden from ages and from generations past."

As Paul wrote words of encouragement to many communities, he identified his pain with the suffering Christ. He was acutely aware of his role and mission.

As our world suffers with war, poverty and injustice, we can identify with ways to ease the suffering of others through prayer, through our voices, through our actions. At the same time take a moment to pray for our priests and ministers striving to bring the peace and comfort of Christ to others. Speak a kind word about your ministers in assisting them in their need. Paul wrote other letters from jail, from shipwreck, unjust trials, yet continued to serve. May we find ways to support our ministers in their ministry and carry out our tasks as well.






