

A quick review of the Combined Councils meeting...

As you can imagine, it ended a bit sadly since the last item on the agenda was an address by Fr. Silva informing us that his time here at CC was coming to an end. Fr. Silva, we will miss you but you are ALWAYS welcome back. And folks, don't forget to RSVP if you plan to attend the Feb. 17 Farewell Reception. If you don't get Flocknote (and why not???) just call the Parish Office with the number attending and we'll make sure there's enough goodies for everyone.

The rest of the meeting though? Well, while most of that meeting is another "Fr. Schiele Monologue," I think the councils survived ②. As I've mentioned, the January combined meeting is when we do an overview of the financial/temporal and pastoral situation of the parish. But in a good way, it's sometimes hard to stay in "overview" mode—and I'm as guilty as anyone in that regard.

What do I mean? Well, as I listed the accomplishments and statistics, of course there are going to be some challenges and concerns that we've faced/need to face. And when that happened, members of the councils were ready to interject and start offering perspective and brainstorming solutions right then and there. It can be so easy to start "talking shop" and try to get a handle on the situation. And it's something that needs to be done. Just not in the context of that particular meeting. But we wanted to. And that's great. Your councils CARE. They care about the financial, spiritual, social, prayerful, service health of this parish. They make my job a LOT easier and their dedication and their sharing their gifts make this community, this family, a better place.

And don't worry...I'll be letting you know about the concerns, especially in the Easter "State of the Parish Address" in that bulletin. And I'll share the accomplishments and triumphs and statistics as well. One of the other pitfalls, so to speak, is that when we're reviewing the previous year, we start looking ahead to the next year (especially in the financial realm since we're already about halfway through the "new" fiscal year). While the financial outlook is decent, some things have come down the pike that are going to need to be looked at. I'll be getting into more detail as that develops.

But the overall view, both financially and pastorally, is a parish that's doing well and making improvements. E.g. the October count—the number of people at the weekend Masses—was up for the second time in two years. That's awesome! It wasn't up by scads but it was up. And that says something good about this parish on all levels. That's the kind of data items we explore at the combined councils meeting and when it's good news, it's something to celebrate. We've got a lot of that going around so stay tuned for more fun and encouraging tidbits of data. Thanks for all YOU do to make this a great parish and God bless.

# FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME FEBRUARY 4, 2024

First Reading: Job 7:1-4, 6-7

In this passage, Job laments the drudgery and pain all people sometimes experience in life. He talks of troubled days and restless nights. But he does mention that the days move along swiftly, which can remind us that our time here on earth is quite limited and should be well spent.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23

Paul explains to the Corinthians that he has no choice, but must preach the gospel. He tells of making himself all things to all people, in order to save some of them. He reminds them that he does this willingly, in the hope of sharing in the blessings of the gospel.



**Gospel: Mark 1:29-39** 

Jesus cured Simon and Andrew's mother of a fever, then others with illnesses or demons came to see him. He cured those who were ill, and cast out the demons of the others. Then he went off and prayed alone until his followers sought him out. Jesus and his disciples then moved on to other villages to proclaim the good news.



#### HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed. Simon, and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, 'Everyone is looking for you'. He told them, 'let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come."

Following His visit to a synagogue, healing Peter's family member and many others, Jesus leaves to be alone in prayer. Did you ever think of the content of that prayer, perhaps gratitude for the healing, for those who responded to His teaching, for the needs which would confront Him in the future in the next village?

In a few brief verses we meet Jesus, as teacher, healer, prayer and with us today companion for others. Simon's statement, 'everyone is looking for you', is repeated for us today, although many do not know the Jesus we know and follow. Our task is to help them end their search and bring Jesus to them.


#### **ADORATION WEDNESDAYS**
