

The Material, the Spiritual and the Moral...

First the Material. I am happy, ecstatic and joyfully proclaiming that the Church roof replacement begins tomorrow!!! (Please imagine the drumrolls and trumpet peals ③). Later start then we'd liked but sometimes paperwork and permits take more time than we'd prefer. But you should have driven up to piles of materials in the parking lot and isn't that a glorious sight? Now, there will be some calendar changes due to this work. When the company is working on the roof, it becomes a hardhat situation—safety!!—so once the 7:15 AM Mass is over, we will be asking folks to exit forthwith. For at least the next two weeks, Wednesday adoration will NOT take place. And the policy for funerals will be as follows: we will be able to celebrate an 11:00 AM Funeral Mass, but we will NOT be able to host calling hours beforehand. We're letting the funeral directors in our area know about that contingency. Hopefully, it will only be for two weeks. But if the weather or other circumstances dictate, it might go into a third week and that will have an impact on the next item in this column, the Spiritual.



Yes, it's possible that the roofing project might go into the week of our 40 Hours Devotions. IF that happens, we probably won't be able to have extended Exposition on Monday and Tuesday—Sunday we'll still be able to. We'll have to play that one by ear. However, we WILL still host the Evening Devotions all THREE evenings. 7:15ish on Sunday, 7:00 PM on Monday and 7:30 PM on Tuesday. So our 40 Hours might turn into 4 Hours but it will still be good. And remember, you'll have to sit in every other pew for this to work. Just follow the signs. Intriguing isn't it?

And finally, the Moral. And the picture says it all. I should have emailed some more flyers from the Bishops' conference about Faithful Citizenship this past week. The rest will be coming this week since the election is that much closer. Voting, and voting our conscience, is a moral act. Not voting is a moral act too—a sin of omission. We might not be excited about our choices in this election. We might be. But we do have an obligation to take part in the leadership of this nation we call our own. Remember, we were all baptized "priest, prophet and king." That "kingship" implies both a power and a responsibility. Being a formed and informed voter—and voting—



exercises both of them. You know I like the mail-in option. And I did—mail in that is. I'd be a hypocrite if I was encouraging you to vote if I didn't myself. But now that I have ②... God bless.

THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

NOVEMBER 3, 2024

First Reading: Deuteronomy 6:2-6

Moses commands the people to love and fear God, and always keep the commandments that they were given. He tells them to observe all statutes so that they will continue to grow and prosper, and tells them that they must love God with all their soul and strength.

Second Reading: Hebrews 7:23-28

Under the old covenant there were many priests, but Jesus will now remain high priest forever because he will live forever, and always be available to those who want to be saved. He does not need to offer sacrifice every day for the sins of his people, because he offered himself up in payment for their sins.

Gospel: Mark 12:28b-34


One of the scribes asked Jesus which commandment is the first, and he replied that the first is to love and honor the Lord and no one else. Jesus explained that they must love God with all their heart, and love their neighbor. The scribe agreed that loving God completely and loving one's neighbor is better than any sacrifice they could make.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Well said, Teacher. You are right in saying 'He is One and there is no other than he.' And 'to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, with all your strength. And to love your neighbor as yourself is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices. And when Jesus saw that he answered with understanding, He said to him, 'You are not far from the kingdom of God.'"

We know there is but one God and we love Him. We know we are to love our neighbor, and the parable of the good Samaritan calls our attention to care and compassion for others, especially those in need. Like the scribe we are comfortable with these answers.

Jesus' reply though provokes another question. If he with his understanding was not far from the kingdom, I ask myself how close or distant am I? Where do I stand, not just answering with words, but with deeds? It is said the greatest distance is eighteen inches from the head to the heart. A recent book indicated that we all give something, Jesus gave it all.


