I've been getting some questions lately about how and what we pray for here at CC, especially the Universal Prayer (AKA Petitions, General Intercessions, Prayer of the Faithful—I think that part of the Mass has had as many names as the Sacrament of Penance, or Confession, or Reconciliation—you get the idea!).

We use a service for our UP that's pretty common among parishes. They look at the Scriptures and any special celebrations that may occur on a given day (Sundays for most of us) and follow the guidelines from the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. Those guidelines are as follows:

### ***The Universal Prayer***

69. *In the Universal Prayer or Prayer of the Faithful, the people respond in some sense to the Word of God which they have received in faith and, exercising the office of their baptismal Priesthood, offer prayers to God for the salvation of all. It is desirable that there usually be such a form of prayer in Masses celebrated with the people, so that petitions may be offered for holy Church, for those who govern with authority over us, for those weighed down by various needs, for all humanity, and for the salvation of the whole world.*

70. *The series of intentions is usually to be:*

- a) for the needs of the Church.*
- b) for public authorities and the salvation of the whole world.*
- c) for those burdened by any kind of difficulty.*
- d) for the local community.*

*Nevertheless, in any particular celebration, such as a Confirmation, a Marriage, or at a Funeral, the series of intentions may be concerned more closely with the particular occasion.*

Note that it says it's a "response" to the Word of God which is why the writers of petitions will stay with scriptural themes. That's why sometimes a petition may seem to come from out of left field but there is a Scriptural link somewhere.

Some of the questions I've gotten are why we're not specific with some of those issues covered by points *c* and *d*. And yes, the questions are about issues that could drift into the political or policy driven arenas. It's not a place that the UP is supposed to go to directly. You'll note that the description of the intentions is pretty general. And that's how the writing service operates as well. At times, and usually tragic times unfortunately, the service will offer a specific prayer addressing the event. The floods in North Carolina a while back; school shootings or the Las Vegas shooting a few years ago. But the intention will be for healing, peace and assistance in general. It won't call for FEMA to act in a certain way, and it won't suggest what should have happened legally to the Las Vegas shooter. They're designed to be a bit open-ended and call for us as disciples to open ourselves to the Holy Spirit and prayerfully discern our own response—and then to respond.

Some may-and have-mentioned that our Pope, some bishops and our USCCB have commented on certain policy and political realities over the past few months and years. Granted, but you'll note that their *medium* of comment has been in addresses, letters and the like. It hasn't been during a homily or the UP. Even the pope's Urbi et Orbi messages are delivered after Mass, not within.

So, unless otherwise instructed, I'll be keeping this course. To do otherwise would lend itself to a different question, namely, why am I imposing MY political opinion or policy thoughts on the parish when I decide on the prayers. I have my thoughts on the political situation and policy decisions just like you do. And I'll "impose" my opinion, you can be sure. How so? You know how so. By my vote. Which will be based those statements of our Pope, bishops and those responsible for leading the Church. And I encourage you to do the same. And if you know me as well as you know me by now, you also know how I'm going to end this column... "Faithful Citizenship." For this country, I consider it the best starting point for how to understand our relationship as disciples and citizens and also how to respond to the issues of the day. God bless.

**SIXTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME**  
**FEBRUARY 15, 2026**

**First Reading: Sirach 15:15-20**  
This passage from Sirach gives strong, unequivocal emphasis to free will in every person. Before each of us is set, sin or virtue, life or death, and each of us are free to choose the one or the other.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10**  
Paul explains to the Corinthians that there are two different kinds of wisdom — the wisdom of God and the wisdom of the world. The wisdom of God is mysterious, but this wisdom has been revealed “to those who love him” through the Spirit.

**Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37**  
In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells the people he has come to fulfill the law. He speaks strongly against murder and anger, against adultery and lust, and against false oaths and lies. He warns the people that unless their virtue exceeds that of the Pharisees, they “will not enter the kingdom of God.”

**HIS WORD TODAY** by Rev. William J. Reilly

**“If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you; if you trust in God you too shall live... Before you are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him, immense is the wisdom of the Lord, he is mighty in power and all seeing. The eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, he understands man’s every deed.”**

How many choices we make every day. Many times, we are not even aware of choosing one thing over another. We decide, period. But there are things of value and great importance which require thought and careful consideration. How do I know the difference?

There are life giving decisions, important family matters, the common good or well-being of others, which tell us, slow down, what are the consequences before you make a rash move. The author tells us to make right and deliberate choices. The phrase ‘what would Jesus do?’ is a point well taken, or as Sirach state ‘if you trust in God, you too shall live.’ ‘Jesus I trust in you.’
