THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT
MARCH 8, 2026

First Reading: Exodus 17:3-7

This story from Exodus reveals that the Israelites, after their escape from Egypt, cast all blame for their sufferings on Moses. In this instance, they were dying of thirst. When Moses appealed to the Lord, the Lord directed Moses to strike a rock and water would gush forth.

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-2, 5-8

Paul reminds the Romans that because Christ died for all people, they are acceptable in God’s sight.

Gospel: John 4:5-42

Jesus converses with the Samaritan woman at Jacob’s Well. When Jesus indicates that whoever drinks from the water He gives will never be thirsty again, the woman immediately answers, “Give me this water, sir...”. Jesus then reveals that she has had five husbands and tells her that He is the Messiah. The woman believes Jesus and proclaims this news to all the townspeople, who believe her and come to see Jesus.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

“Since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in hope of the glory of God. And hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts by the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. For Christ, while we were still helpless, died at the appointed time for the ungodly.”

How reassuring listening to the word of St. Paul, a letter, written before the four gospels. Think for a moment on the meaning of the words – justified, peace, grace, faith.

Living in this holy year of hope, whose theme is taken from Paul’s letter, ‘Hope does not disappoint’, we are both graced and strengthened as we continue our journey to Calvary.



