It's a column that starts with personnel and then segues to calendars, planning and projects. It's an interesting time right now which begets this interesting column.

Personnel. Not sure how to put it otherwise. We're looking forward to Shawn Terkhorn's ordination to the Permanent Diaconate in two weeks on May 9th. Shawn, you and the family are in our prayers. And hopefully everyone is responding so we have a sense of how many folks will be attending the reception on May 10th after the 11:30 AM Mass where Shawn will minister and preach for the first time. That Flocknote should be in your inboxes.

Will we also be celebrating Shawn getting assigned here at CC? *That's been my daily prayer for a month or more now!* But as I write this column, I just don't know. Neither does Shawn. We won't find out until much closer to the ordination. And that uncertainty about clergy personnel also affects calendars. Will CC get a parochial vicar (assistant to the pastor) this year? Again, no idea. Eight men are being ordained to the priesthood a week after Shawn's ordination, but I still just don't know. And that uncertainty until mid-May is the reason I haven't made a decision about going to a "summer schedule" for weekend Mass or not. How many priests will be available is still up in the air. I'll make a decision as soon as I can, which is as soon as I know what our situation is going to be. I have to allow for retreats and vacations for the priests, and we all have to remember how many of the wonderful priests who help us are retired. That's a major consideration for our scheduling.

Another major consideration to scheduling this year has to do with archdiocesan mandates. This spring/summer we have the following projects we have to do. One, the annual Safe Environment audit. Two, a procedures and practices audit for the Parish Office, especially the Business Office. Three is a mandated transition to a new payroll system for all employees. And four, a mandated transition to a new parish census program. We're just beginning that one and it will be going through at least mid-June. If it seems our awesome staff is just a LITTLE bit overwhelmed, well... To help with this, ***the 2027 Mass Intention Book will not open until AFTER the July 4th weekend.*** I know it's later than we've done recently but considering everything else, it needs to be done.

Between this and the physical plant projects I've already mentioned, it's going to be a very BUSY summer. But it won't be all "nose to the grindstone." The Parish Picnic will be happening on June 14th and plans for that are well underway, and it will be a welcome break from everything. So, make sure to mark your calendars and plan to P-A-R-T-A-Y! I know I will 😊.

And to our younger parishioners joining us at the Table of the Lord for the first time this weekend, welcome to the work; welcome to the sometimes confusion and sometimes craziness of parish life but most importantly, welcome to the joy and presence of Jesus in your lives. It's that Presence that gets us through all the uncertainty and the projects and the questions and leads us to the breaks and the joy and peace that come from being close to Him. Enjoy that Presence and learn to share it. God bless.

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

MAY 3, 2026

First Reading: Acts 6:1-7

During the early growth of the Church, the apostles realized that they needed more disciples in order to carry out effectively the ministry of the Church. The community selected seven men, one of whom was Stephen.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:4-9

Citing many uses of the word “stone” in the sayings of Jesus and in the Old Testament, Peter urges the Christians to be “living stones...an edifice of spirit.”

Gospel: John 14:1-12

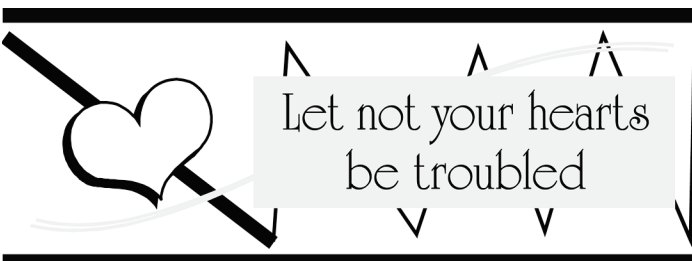
In this beautiful passage from the words of Jesus at the Last Supper, Jesus promises that he is preparing a place for the apostles. He tells them, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through me.” When Philip asks Jesus to show them the Father, Jesus answers, “Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.”

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

“Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to ministry of the word. The proposal was acceptable to the whole community... They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands upon them.”

The Acts of the Apostles, the story of the life of the primitive church, discloses an important step in the growth and structure of the church. Here we discover the choice of the first deacons, part of the sacrament of Holy Orders. As we reflect on the inspiration of the Spirit and the response of the community, may we look to the needs of the church today.

How aware we are of the need of disciples to serve the church today and for tomorrow. It is a concern for all Catholics. May I take a moment and ask myself, when did I encourage a person to follow the Lord as a priest, deacon or the religious life of a brother or sister? Rather than lament the lack of vocations, may I pray for and encourage others to listen to the call of the Lord. May we pray that those who the Lord is calling today, and He is, may hear and respond.

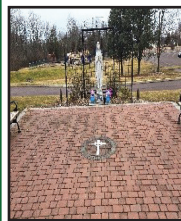

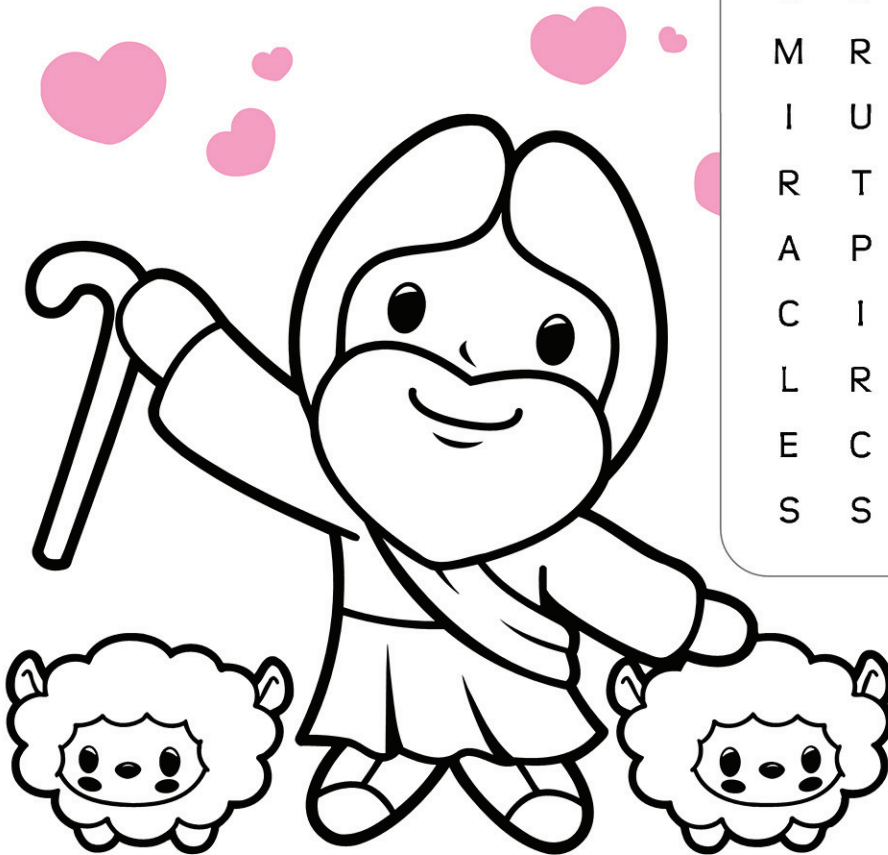
