First Reading: Ezekiel 18:25-28

Ezekiel reminds the people that if a sinner turns away from his iniquity, he will live, not die.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:1-11

Paul urges the converts at Philippi to be united in spirit and ideals, avoiding rivalry and dissension. He ends with the beautiful hymn extolling the humility and sacrifice of Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 21:28-32

Jesus speaks words of rebuke to the chief priests and the elders because they are not believing the teachings of John the Baptist. He warns them that tax collectors and prostitutes, who do believe John, will enter the Kingdom of God before them.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

“Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus, who though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness, and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.”

How beautiful the teaching of Saint Paul calling us to be like Jesus. Reread these powerful words. Remember, this is God wishing to join us, the human race, while still remaining God, because of His love, wanting to save and rescue us. He came because of our need.

We often hear the expression, ‘you have an attitude’, usually reflecting a negative judgment. Not so today, as Paul is encouraging us to assume our oneness with Jesus, giving of ourselves, as He who emptied, poured out everything for us and our salvation. That attitude can be one of service and care so that others know how great Jesus’ love is for them today.

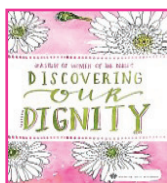
(A Women's Bible Study)

Gospel Today | 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time | Mt 20:1-16a

Jesus makes it clear that the believers will all have an equal share in Heaven.

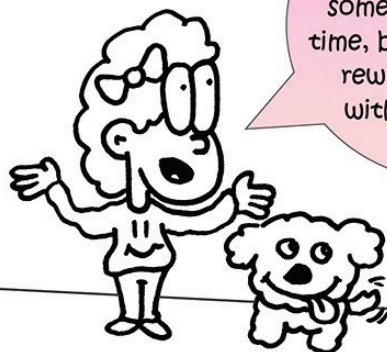

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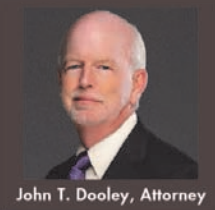
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
