### FEAST OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD A Holy Day of Obligation Masses: May 8th at 7:00 pm May 9th at 9:00 am & 5:15 pm



The Ascension is the event where Jesus arose bodily into heaven at the end of his time on earth.

Jesus' time on earth began with his birth. It was interrupted for three days by His death on the Cross. During that time, He descended into the realm of the dead and preached the Gospel to the good people who died before Him. This allowed those good and holy souls--the righteous dead, as we call them--who accepted Christ as their Savior to proceed to heaven. On the third day after his death and burial, Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, an event we call the Resurrection. He spent the next 40 days preaching and preparing His disciples to perform the work of preaching and baptizing all people.

At the end of this 40 day period, Jesus brought his apostles to the Mount of Olives where He ascended into heaven. We call this the Ascension.

By His death and Resurrection, Jesus opened the gates of heaven for all humanity. His Ascension demonstrates this to us. It is His proof that those of us who believe in Him in faith and follow Him will also be raised on the last day, and enter into heaven. From heaven, Jesus hears our prayers and intercedes for us with His Father.




