

Fast & Abstinence

- All persons who have reached their 14th birthday are bound by the law of abstinence.
 - All adults are bound by the law of fast up to their 60th year.
- ✚ **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **Abstinence** from meat & also days of **Fast**; (We are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal.)
- ✚ The other Fridays of Lent remain days of abstinence from meat.


