

a note from Father John

At mass this weekend we will bless our devices. A study last year found American teenagers averaged 237 phone notifications per day. They can't go 5 minutes without a device clamoring for their attention. School districts across the country are grappling with anti-phone policies, as test scores still have not rebounded since pandemic. But let's be honest – not only teenagers struggle with this. Average screen time in the U.S. hit 7 hours and 3 minutes. If we spent nearly half our waking hours on any other compulsion, our family would hold an intervention.

We have to ask ourselves, what is this doing to us? Even as connectivity broadens, allowing us – obliging us – to interact constantly with family, friends, and coworkers, the connection gets shallower. Television, computers, smartphones, tablets, smartwatches, earbuds, VR headsets creep into every corner of our lives. We are always online. Our system, overstimulated, locks down in self-defense. Our capacity to interact meaningfully with the world, and with each other, atrophies. It dulls our connection to reality. We type words in comment threads we would never say in real life. Is there a person on the other end? What is Al-generated, what is a filter, what is real?

In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "If your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. Better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into Gehenna" (Mk 9:47).

If your smartphone causes you to sin? Set App Limits and Parental Controls. Charge it overnight in the living room, instead of the bedroom. Use Focus and Do Not Disturb so you can work, study, eat a meal, have a conversation, live in the moment rather than "living at the mercy of the telephone" (C.S. Lewis, Prince Caspian).

Not because technology is bad, but because we are baptized into Christ's kingship. We are meant to own our devices, not be owned by them. We are meant to use technology, not be used by it. We are kings and queens. We have a sacred dignity. We are made in God's image and we are made for eternal life in heaven. "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have life, and have it in abundance" (Jn 10:10). Let's live abundantly!
