A Note from Fr. John



"You are light in the Lord."

In his letter to the Ephesians, Saint Paul reminds us that through Christ, we are no longer defined by darkness, but transformed to live as children of the light. This light is not something we keep to ourselves. It is a gift meant to be shared — a call to embody God's love and carry it into the world. Through an extraordinary range of spiritual, pastoral, educational, and charitable works, the Church truly stands as a beacon of kindness, hope, and healing in our communities.

Our faith calls each of us to gratitude for God's abundant blessings — and it also calls us to compassion and empathy for one another. When we live out our faith through concrete actions, we strengthen the ministry of the Church both within our parishes and far beyond them. Your faith, generosity, and commitment are a powerful witness to Christ's love in action.

The 2026 Annual Appeal is one of the most important ways we come together to care for one another and to build a vibrant, faithful community. Your gifts make it possible for the Church to serve in ways that no single parish could accomplish alone.




