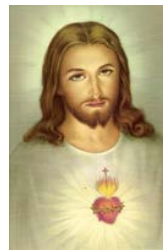

Yes, your family can practice the work of mercy of burying the dead.

Let's take a step back and consider how the Catholic Church accompanies those who have died and their mourning loved ones. The Order of Christian Funerals says:

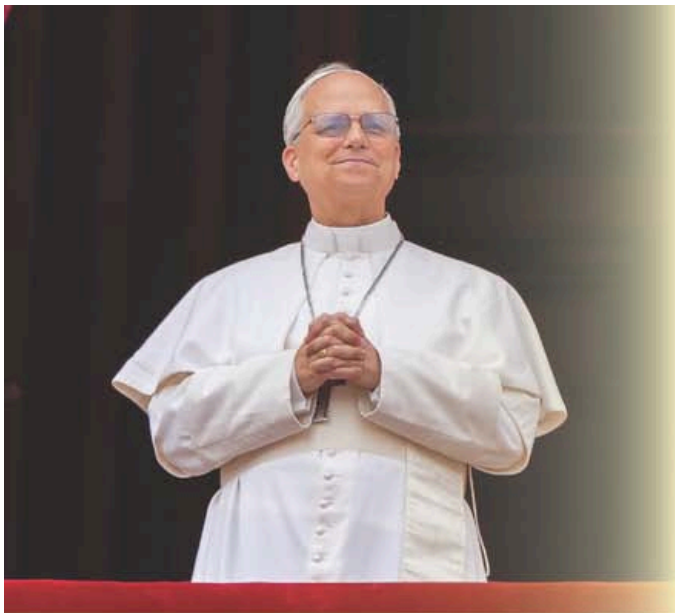
"Christian consolation is rooted in that hope that comes from faith in the saving death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. ... The Church calls each member of Christ's Body – priest, deacon, layperson – to participate in the ministry of consolation: to care for the dying, to pray for the dead, to comfort those who mourn."

My son, shed tears for one who is dead  
with wailing and bitter lament;  
As is only proper, prepare the body,  
absent not yourself from his burial.  
(Sirach 38:16)

- Attend the funerals of the departed. Not only is it good to pray for those who have died, but to show up out of respect for the dead and for the comfort of their families is an important thing in human society.
- Take a walk through a cemetery and pray a rosary for those buried there. Pray for those who may have been forgotten, and have no one else to intercede for them.
- Organize a cemetery cleanup day. This is a great outdoor service opportunity for young children who can rake leaves or remove dried flowers or wreaths.
- Volunteer with the Arimatheans to help with funeral repasts. Consider it a hidden act of charity and a way to offer consolation without directly knowing the deceased.
- The Order of Christian Funerals says that members of the community should console the mourners with words of faith and support, and with acts of kindness. This is the layperson's time to step up and offer help.
  - Consider the everyday tasks you do. Could your family take on one of these tasks or errands for a family in your faith community during their time of mourning?
  - Send cards and flowers to the grieving family.
  - Donate to a cause that is special to the family.
  - Make food or schedule meal deliveries for the family.
  - Go visit the family and comfort them.
  - Help clean out the home of the deceased.
  - Help pay bills related to the funeral.
- Give respect to the corporal remains of those who have died by stopping your car and waiting respectfully while a funeral procession passes.
- Pray a Hail Mary or the Eternal Rest prayer when passing a cemetery.
- Assist with the burial expenses for a poor person who has died. No one should have to be treated as "lesser" just because they were poor in this life.
- Spend time planning your own funeral Mass, read through the Order of Christian Funerals, and find our hope in the Resurrection.

### SACRED HEART CONSECRATION

The U.S. bishops have consecrated the country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. All Catholics are encouraged to join them in praying for our country. One opportunity to participate is by contributing to a collective 250 Hours of Adoration and 250 Works of Mercy. Simply pray some rosaries, come and sit in adoration, give food to our food pantry, or do a few acts of charity for someone in need, offering up what you do intentionally to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and for our country. Please join your fellow parishioners in prayer and adoration for this important spiritual work of mercy for our country!

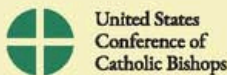

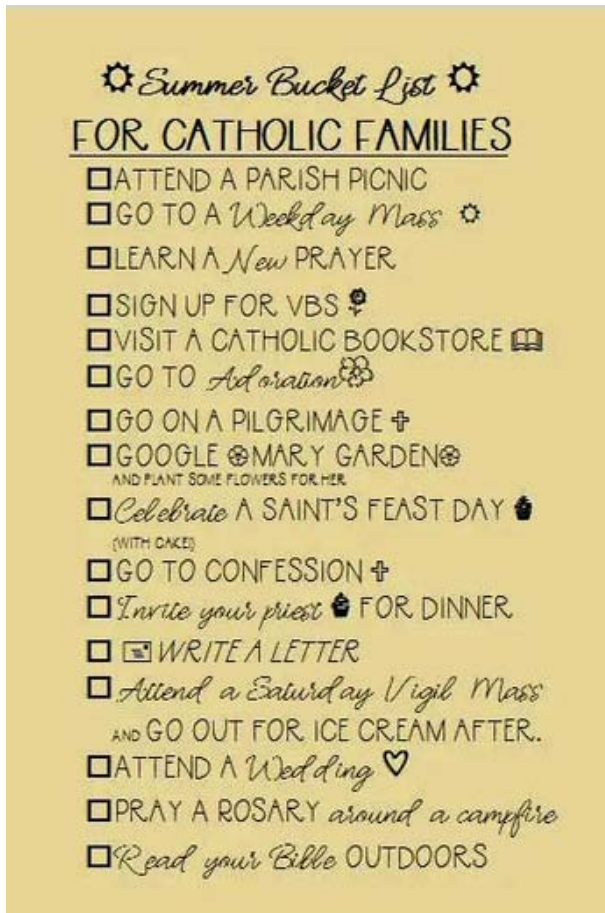

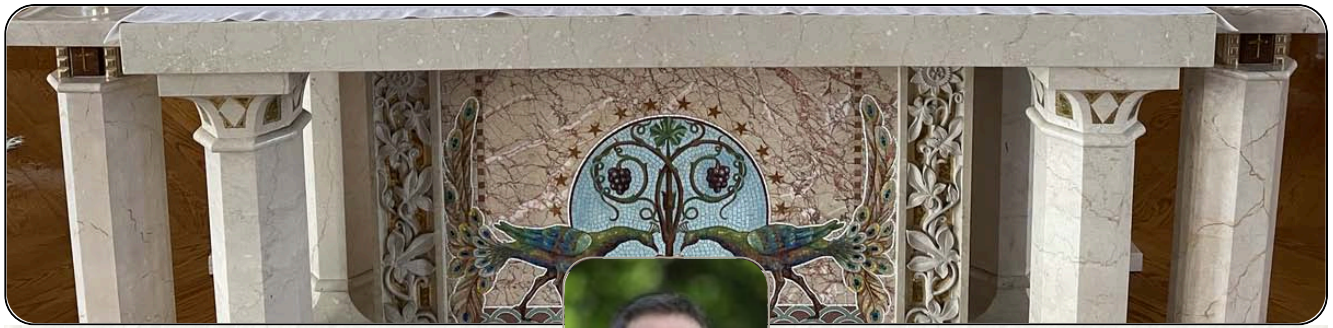

## A Note from Fr. John



## Una Nota del Fr. John

Between 70,000 and 150,000. That's how many hairs are on your head. And God has counted every last one of them (Matthew 10:30).

Precisely where you fall in that range depends mostly on genetics. Men have up to 15% denser hair than women. Blonde hair is thinner and higher density, so blondes tend to be closer to that 150,000 upper range. Brown and black hair is thicker and lower density, averaging around 100,000 strands. Red hair is the least dense, in that 70,000 lower range. These numbers are good estimates based on imaging and extrapolation. Even with all our technological advancements, we can't get an exact count.

There are three stages in the life cycle of a hair strand. The Anagen phase, in which hair grows about a centimeter per month, last from 2 to 7 years. Up to 90% of the hair on your head is in the Anagen phase. In the Catagen phase, the hair stops growing. This process takes a couple of weeks. Then begins the Telogen phase, in which a new hair starts growing underneath the old one, which can stay in place for 3 to 4 months until it falls out and comes to its final resting place in your shower drain.

God's love for us is not generic, it's not hands-off, it's not distant or aloof. Philosophers have thought that since God is perfect and unchanging, he couldn't know the particulars about us, he could only know the "idea" of us in a kind of universal way. But God has revealed himself to us in Jesus Christ, and he has revealed that he loves each of us in a personal way. Love cares about details. God cares enough to know our name, what kind of toppings we like on our pizza, and how many hairs we have on our head.

Entre 70.000 y 150.000. Esa es la cantidad de cabellos que tienes en la cabeza. Y Dios los ha contado todos (Mateo 10, 30).

El número exacto depende principalmente de la genética. Los hombres tienen cabello hasta un 15 % más denso que las mujeres. El cabello rubio es más fino pero de mayor densidad, entonces los rubios tienden a tener una cantidad más cercana a los 150.000 cabellos. El cabello castaño y negro es más grueso y de menor densidad, con un promedio de unos 100.000 cabellos. El cabello rojo es el menos denso, más cercana a los 70.000 cabellos. Estos números son estimaciones basadas en técnicas de imagen y extrapolación. Incluso con todos nuestros avances tecnológicos, no podemos obtener una cifra exacta.

El ciclo de vida de un cabello tiene tres etapas. La fase anágena, en la que el cabello crece aproximadamente 1 cm al mes, dura entre 2 y 7 años. Hasta el 90 % del cabello de la cabeza se encuentra en esta fase anágena. En la fase catágena, el crecimiento del cabello se detiene; este proceso dura un par de semanas. A continuación comienza la fase telógena, en la que un nuevo cabello empieza a crecer debajo del antiguo; este último puede permanecer en su sitio entre 3 y 4 meses hasta que se desprende y acaba en su lugar de descanso final: el desagüe de la ducha.

Algunos filósofos han pensado que Dios, siendo perfecto e inmutable, no podría conocer los detalles particulares sobre nosotros, sino solo la «idea» de nosotros de una manera universal. Sin embargo, Dios se ha revelado a nosotros en Jesucristo y ha manifestado que ama a cada uno de nosotros de forma personal. El amor se preocupa por los detalles. Dios se preocupa lo suficiente por nosotros como para saber nuestro nombre, qué ingredientes preferimos en la pizza, y cuántos cabellos tenemos en la cabeza.

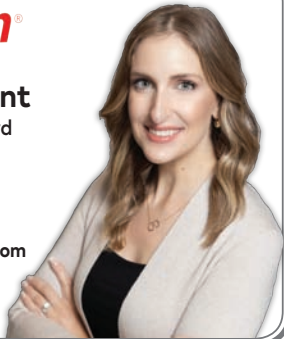
