

# Holy Cross Church welcomes Mr. Colin Snyder, Pastoral Year Seminarian!



Colin Snyder is the oldest of ten children, three boys and seven girls. He first desired to become a priest when he read the life of St. John Marie Vianney in elementary school. This desire was reinforced by altar serving at Sacred Heart Church in Bowie, Maryland, and by the witness of holy priests. Colin was homeschooled through high school before he enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard for two years. The decision to enter seminary was a difficult one, because Colin has strong desires for marriage and family. However, Our

Lady of Fatima made it clear to him on October 13th, 2017, which is the 100th anniversary of the Fatima miracle, that God was calling him to enter Seminary and discern a vocation to the priesthood. Colin is in his sixth of eight years as a seminarian. He is residing in Holy Cross parish this year to pray and discern before making his final vows to the Lord at his diaconate ordination in 2025. ## Relics of St. Jude is coming to Maryland!



# **Information Session on Physician Assisted Suicide**

Andrew Rivas, manager for Public Policy and Advocacy for the Archdiocese of Washington, will be speaking in Caulfield Hall, Saint Jane de Chantal, 9701 Old Georgetown Road, Bethesda, Maryland, 20814, on Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 11- 12pm, immediately after the 10am Mass. Mr. Rivas will be discussing the Maryland legislature's proposed bill to make physician-assisted suicide legal; as well as the abortion amendment slated to be on the 2024 November election ballot. The amendment seeks to take away parental rights:

children could have abortions and transgender treatments and surgeries without parental permission and without parental knowledge. It will be important that all people of faith keep our elected officials in our prayers as they address a wide array of very important issues this year. We will also need to write, call, and email our elected officials so they know what we as a community of faith, support and what we oppose. Let us join together with Mr. Rivas and help in this important effort.
