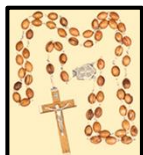

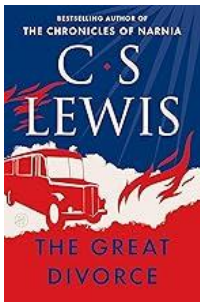

Salt can corrode concrete, harm pets, and damage plants. Once it gets into our waterways, it doesn't go away!

WSSCWater recommends:

- Shovel right away before snow turns to ice.
- Use less salt--if you must use salt, a 12-oz. mug is enough for 10 sidewalk squares or for a 20-foot driveway.
- Sweep and collect salt for reuse to keep it from our waterways.
