# SECURITY UPGRADE GOALS

## SECURITY UPGRADE FOR THE CHURCH AND THE RECTORY

Thank you to those parishioners who donated towards the cost of the security upgrade for the campus. The cost of the project is as follows:

### **RECTORY AND CHURCH**

Video monitors in the Rectory - \$6,000 Panic button in the Church - \$3,000 Rectory door access control and cameras - \$7,500 Total: \$16,500

### CHURCH, SCHOOL, AND RECTORY

Upgrade to whole campus camera system - \$70,000

#### SCHOOL

Access control system and door alarms - \$40,000

#### **TOTAL PROJECT COST - \$126,500**

So far we have raised \$1,410 in donations to the Church towards the \$16,500 expenses for the Church and Rectory.

Current school parents and alumni families have contributed at the School Gala and through the Annual Fund to cover the cost of the campus-wide cameras system and school entry and door alarms -\$110,000.


