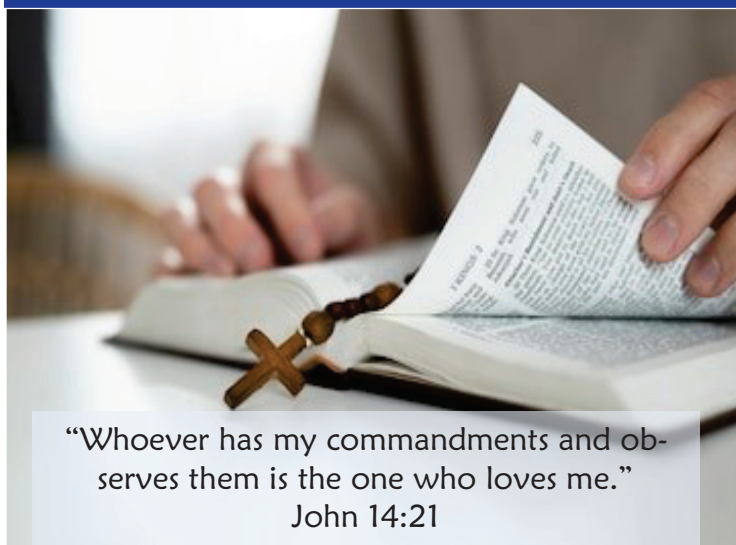

## Dancing with God



“I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you (John 14:20).”

In this single sentence, Jesus reveals the heart of the Christian mystery. The Father and the Son live in perfect communion through the Holy Spirit — and that same Spirit draws us into their divine life. We live in God, and God lives in us. This mutual indwelling is not an abstract doctrine; it is the very rhythm of our existence. It is the dance of love that shapes our identity and binds us to one another. To be Christian is to enter this divine dance — to move with God and around God, carried by the Spirit.

The Church, then, is not a random gathering of people or a voluntary club of like-minded individuals. Nor is it merely a set of inherited structures, rules, or hierarchies. The Church is the people of God, the Body of Christ made visible in the world, the living temple of the Holy Spirit. If this is true, then we cannot allow ourselves to be consumed by internal conflicts or institutional anxieties. The real question is simpler and more demanding: When the world looks at us, do they recognize the ongoing work of Christ?

Listen again to the risen Lord:

“The Father who dwells in me is doing his works... Whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these (Jn 14:10, 12).”

Jesus promises that the Spirit will empower us to continue — and even surpass — his visible works. This means that Christian action is never merely the product of our talent, creativity, or generosity. Every good impulse, every stirring of compassion, every desire to serve begins with God. Even the most generous philanthropists often remain humble and anonymous because they sense that the original prompting did not come from themselves. It came from the Spirit.

Our very existence is a gift. Our parents cooperated with the Creator in bringing us into life, and from that moment our lives have unfolded as a web of relationships — with God and with one another. Without relationships, we wither. Without love, we dry up. But when love is received and shared, we flourish. Every human being is a child of God, regardless of origin, religion, nationality, or ideology. God knows each of us by name. This is why dialogue is not optional for Christians: interreligious dialogue, ecumenical dialogue, dialogue with scientists, with seekers, even with atheists. We speak because God has already spoken to each person.

Through such encounters, we extend the joy of the Gospel. We participate in a “dialogue of salvation,” helping restore the integrity of God’s plan for the world. We announce His mercy, His peace, and the coming of His Kingdom. And we do so with confidence, because God — not any earthly power — is ultimately in charge. Wherever false claims to ultimate authority arise, we must gently but firmly unmask them. Only God is the giver of life. Only God is the goal of history.

And here is the astonishing truth: every one of us is personally invited into this divine movement. We are called to dance with God — now, in this life, and forever in the life to come. This is why our message is truly Gospel, truly good news. God draws near, takes us by the hand, and leads us into the eternal dance of love.

grace of God and eternal joy. Amen.

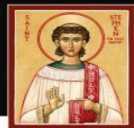

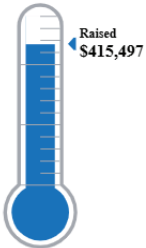

## Danzando con Dios



«Yo estoy en mi Padre, y ustedes en mí y yo en ustedes (Juan 14:20)».

En esta única frase, Jesús revela el corazón del misterio Cristiano. El Padre y el Hijo viven en perfecta comunión a través del Espíritu Santo, y ese mismo Espíritu nos atrae hacia su vida divina. Nosotros vivimos en Dios, y Dios vive en nosotros. Esta convivencia mutua no es una doctrina indeterminada; es el ritmo mismo de nuestra existencia. Es la danza del amor que moldea nuestra identidad y nos une los unos a los otros. Ser cristiano es entrar en esta danza divina: moverse con Dios y alrededor de Dios, impulsados por el Espíritu.

La Iglesia, entonces, no es una reunión casual de personas ni un club voluntario de individuos con ideas afines. Tampoco es simplemente un conjunto de estructuras, normas o jerarquías heredadas. La Iglesia es el pueblo de Dios, el Cuerpo de Cristo hecho visible en el mundo, el templo vivo del Espíritu Santo. Si esto es cierto, entonces no podemos permitir que nos consuman los conflictos internos o las ansiedades institucionales. La verdadera pregunta es más sencilla y más exigente: cuando el mundo nos mira, ¿reconoce la obra continua de Cristo? Escuchen de nuevo al Señor resucitado:

«El Padre que habita en mí es quien realiza sus obras... El que cree en mí hará también las obras que yo hago, y hará otras mayores (Jn 14:10, 12)».

Jesús promete que el Espíritu nos capacitará para continuar —e incluso superar— sus obras visibles. Esto significa que la acción cristiana nunca es meramente el producto de nuestro talento, creatividad o generosidad. Todo buen impulso, todo retoño de compasión, todo deseo de servir comienza en Dios. Incluso los filántropos más generosos con frecuencia permanecen humildes y anónimos, pues perciben que el impulso original no provino de ellos mismos, sino del Espíritu.

Nuestra propia existencia es un don. Nuestros padres cooperaron con el Creador para traernos a la vida y, desde ese momento, nuestras vidas se han desplegado como una red de relaciones: con Dios y entre nosotros. Sin relaciones, nos marchitamos. Sin amor, nos secan. Pero cuando el amor se recibe y se comparte, florecemos. Todo ser humano es hijo de Dios, independientemente de su origen, religión, nacionalidad o ideología. Dios conoce a cada uno de nosotros por su nombre. Por eso, el diálogo no es opcional para los cristianos: el diálogo interreligioso, el diálogo ecuménico, el diálogo con los científicos, con los buscadores e incluso con los ateos. Hablamos porque Dios ya ha hablado a cada persona.

A través de estos encuentros, extendemos la alegría del Evangelio. Participamos en un «diálogo de salvación», ayudando a restaurar la integridad del plan de Dios para el mundo. 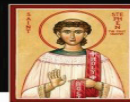

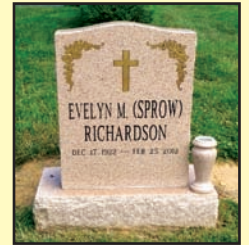
