FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Eucharistic Revival

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Anthony's,

The following is taken from the National Eucharist Revival web page:

"Jesus is calling us deeper."

"He promises to restore and renew his people."

"Our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength. Jesus Christ invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery here in the United States by helping us renew our worship in Jesus Christ in the Eucharist."

Here at St. Anthony's I think we are already doing a pretty good job in regard to our devotion to the Holy Eucharist, but we could always do better. Some times to give praise to our Eucharistic Lord, outside of the ordinary Mass times, are Friday Holy Hour after the 8 am Mass and the Monday night Adoration and confessions from 6 to 8 pm. And of course, we have the chapel at the convent which can be accessed 24/7, unless there is a retreat going on in the convent house.

My priesthood has always been about the Eucharist. I remember the very first homily I gave at St. Anthony's was about the preeminence of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the one thing I love the most about being a Catholic priest; its really the only reason I wanted to be a priest, so that I could be as close to the Eucharist as I could. In my rectory I live with the Eucharistic presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ in my chapel. One of the first things I did when I came to the parish was to have a chapel built in the attic space of the rectory so as to have Our Lord present with me as I work and live at St. Anthony's. Many of you know this and as you walk the boardwalk, bless yourselves when you pass the rectory house. It is a great honor to be your priest and to see you fall in love with Our Lord in the Sacrament of His Love.

Jesus told St. Margaret Mary Alacoque to make reparation for all the sins committed against the Eucharist. One sin that we can make reparation for are the times we carry on frivolous conversations in the presence of the Eucharist while in the church after the Mass is over. I know I have said this before, and I will say it again; the talk that goes on after Mass by a number of people standing right in the church in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament is a sacrilege and must be stopped. I know you are good people, but common sense should tell you that you should go to the social hall or outside to carry on your conversations.

If there is one thing I hope the Eucharistic Revival can resolve in our parish is to stop the talking after Mass in the church. Some people are still trying to pray or light devotional candles. I preach this to myself too. I confess that I am guilty of this foolishness.

As we begin the Eucharistic Revival, may we honor Our Lord in the Sacrament of His Love by paring the ultimate respect for His Sacred Presence.

Jesus says that He is the vine and we are the branches. Branches grow out from a vine and receive their food from the main stem. They grow leaves and bear fruit.






