As I write this, it's the anniversary of the Miracle of the Sun at Fatima. Our Lady instructed the three shepherd children to:

- Pray the Rosary daily.
- Make sacrifices for sinners.
- Offer reparations for the offenses against her Immaculate Heart.

After each mystery of the Rosary, we are to say this prayer:

"Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those most in need of thy mercy."

In the revelations at Fatima, Our Lady spoke about ending the Great War and preventing the destruction of our world. Having been to Fatima, I can attest to the great holiness I experienced there.

Portugal in 1917 was on the verge of communism and ruled by Masons. They did everything in their power to prevent the crowd of 70,000+people from seeing the miracle promised by Our Lady. The secular press attempted to characterize the three shepherd children as fools or liars, but the dancing sun was seen by too many for them to deny. Her call to pray the Rosary is not new; on October 7th, 1571, we remember when Pope Pius V asked everyone to pray the Rosary, which, through a miracle saved the Christian fleet at Lepanto thus preventing a Muslim invasion of Italy.

The readings for today—Exodus 17, Psalm 12, 2 Timothey 3, and Luke 18—all focus on persistent prayer. Jesus taught us about this persistence in the parable of the judge who feared a "persistent" woman. Our persistence demonstrates our discipline (though I know "discipline" can seem like a harsh word, it is essential for achieving holiness). St. Augustine said:

"Why does God ask us to pray if He knows our needs? It may confuse us unless we understand that He wants us to express our desires through prayer. This prepares us to receive the great gifts He has for us, as our capacity is often too small to embrace them. We must enlarge our desires and not be tied to unbelievers."

Like our muscles, prayer needs exercise to grow. Throughout your day, there are limitless opportunities to pray.

There are five types of prayer:

- Blessing and Adoration
- Petition
- Intercession
- Thanksgiving
- Praise

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Just as sheep recognize their shepherd's voice, we become more attuned to Jesus when we pray unfailingly.

Sisters and brothers we are in a battle, the evil one is becoming bolder every day. We cannot respond with hatred or by using their tactics but instead with love. Jesus asked us to pray for our enemies and this is our best defense.



October 22nd is the Feast Day of Saint John Paul II. Having his Feast Day in October is very fitting, as he was an impactful voice regarding the dignity of life (Respect Life Month) and had a lifelong devotion to our Mother Mary (Month of Our Lady of the Rosary). 


