CLERGY CORNER

Happy Easter everyone and I pray that all the joyful words and actions of our Lord Jesus Christ have brought you a renewed sense of happiness to each and every moment of your life.

It is only in the power of the Holy Spirit gifted to St. Peter that we see him preach boldly about who He is in Christ and whom we are to follow. In our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we truly see St. Peter's powerful transformation as a promoter of the faith that he learnt in his previous three year with the greatest Master and Teacher of our faith. We also need to remember that this "transformation" came with great cost to Peter as well.

Perhaps we ought to direct our attention to one line in the first reading. Peter strongly tells us to, and I quote, "to really free yourself from this corrupt generation." He shares with us that the only way to do this is repenting of our sins and being baptized for the forgiveness of our sins which is the only way to receive an outpouring, or a renewed sense of the grace that comes from living in our daily commitment to living in the glory of God.

Please remember this final inspirational thought from our second reading in 1 Peter:
"By his words you have been healed. For you had gone astray like sheep, but you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your souls."

Continue to live in the Spirit of Easter Joy as you bask in this Savior of ours who never abandons us.

SACRAMENTS

Baptism: Contact the parish office for more information and to schedule an appointment with a priest early in the pregnancy. Scheduling: Baptisms take place after the 11:30 am Mass on the first and second Sundays of the month. Pre-Baptism Workshops take place on the last Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm in the Parish Office, registration required.

Marriage: Ideally, engaged couples should contact the Parish Office one year prior to the scheduled date.

Anointing of the Sick and Communion Calls: Call the rectory any time for the Sacrament of the Sick and for arrangements to visit the sick or elderly with the Eucharist. A Catholic chaplain is also available at the hospital.

Contact the Religious Education Office to register students for our Parish Religious Education Program.
