CLERGY CORNER

In this Sunday's Gospel, I read something that stopped me. Jesus tells the Twelve, "Do not go into pagan territory or enter a Samaritan town. Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

That line can raise a question. Did Jesus leave everyone else out?

No. Jesus gave the apostles their first mission. He told them where to begin.

The Good Shepherd first sent them to the people of the covenant, the people who knew God's promises but still wandered like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus did not close the door on the rest of the world. He opened the mission in the place closest to home.

That matters for us at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. We can look at the needs of the whole world and feel helpless. We can see war, sickness, anger, loneliness, and confusion, and wonder where to start. Jesus gives us a place to start. Begin close to home.

Look for the tired person. Call the family member who drifted away. Notice the quiet parishioner who sits alone. Encourage the Catholic who wonders if he or she still belongs. Speak with patience. Listen with selfless love. Jesus looked at the crowd with pity. Then Jesus sent the Twelve.

Christ still does that. He sees wounded people, and he sends ordinary disciples to carry his mercy into ordinary places.

The mission does not always begin far away. Sometimes it begins in the next pew, the next phone call, the next conversation, or the next act of kindness.

SACRAMENTS

Baptism: Contact the parish office for more information and to schedule an appointment with a priest early in the pregnancy. Scheduling: Baptisms take place after the 11:30 am Mass on the first and second Sundays of the month. Pre-Baptism Workshops take place on the last Tuesday of the month at 6:00 pm in the Parish Office, registration required.

Marriage: Ideally, engaged couples should contact the Parish Office one year prior to the scheduled date.

Anointing of the Sick and Communion Calls: Call the rectory any time for the Sacrament of the Sick and for arrangements to visit the sick or elderly with the Eucharist. A Catholic chaplain is also available at the hospital.

Contact the Religious Education Office to register students for our Parish Religious Education Program.

Contact Deacon Rich Wigglesworth with O.C.I.A. for adults seeking sacramental preparation.

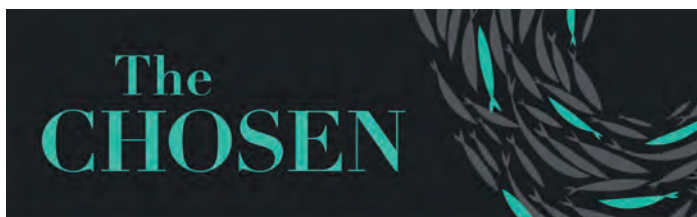
