HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

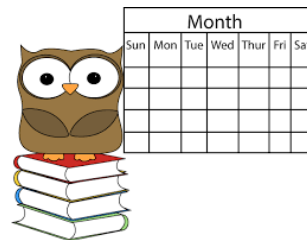

Dear Parishioners,

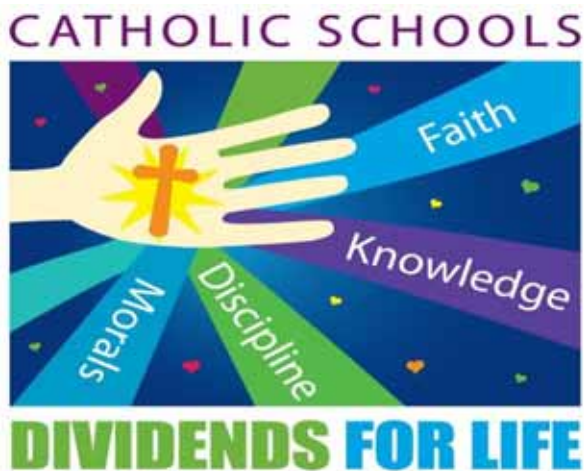
