

Dear Parishioners,

I want to thank our Share the Care Ministry. Our website says Share the Care "provides accompaniment and support to those in need, especially to those who are unable to leave their homes and their caretakers."

One of the first interactions I remember having with the ministry was their telling me that they had been visiting a man to allow his wife a break from her duties so she could run errands and do what she needed to do to provide for her and her husband's needs. They told me that the wife was so grateful that she was considering joining the ministry. Eventually she did and she serves with a joyfilled smile.

The other day, I received an email from the head of the ministry, Vienna Drago, letting me know of two parishioners who are confined to their homes who would like to receive Holy Communion. The one had received a visit from Deacon Rich Maxwell a few weeks ago and she was hoping to receive again. The other is confined to her home alongside of her husband and was extremely grateful over the phone just to know that someone was planning to bring her Holy Communion.

When I met with the second woman, I asked her how she got in touch with Share the Care. She said that her son had made the arrangements for her.

I want to thank Share the Care for several reasons – for making themselves a first point of contact on behalf of the parish for those in need, for visiting with these parishioners and attending to their needs, and for connecting these parishioners to the parish, which becomes a joy for all involved.

If you are interested in ministering to those at home, whether as part of the Share the Care ministry, or as a Eucharistic Minister who brings Holy Communion to another parishioner at home on a weekly basis, your service would be very welcome and I think fulfilling too.
