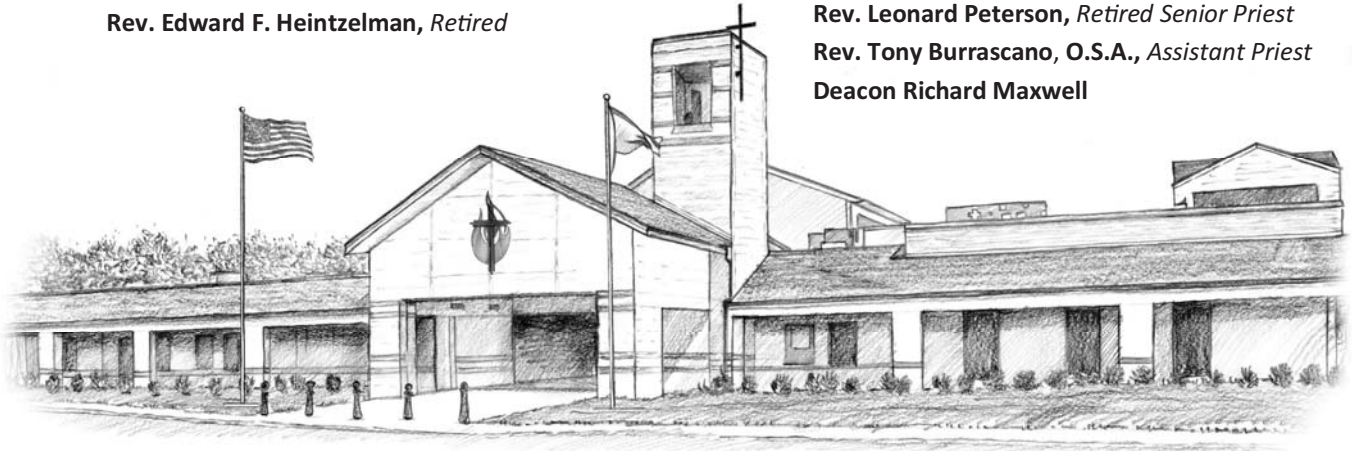

### **Jesus - The Good Teacher**

*“Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? ... When fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher”* (Lk 6:39-40). Who are the teachers in our lives through whom we first come to know about Jesus? As children, our parents, teachers, and pastors expose us to Jesus' teachings and lay the foundation for our first experience with Jesus' healing love and the true freedom He offers. Without good teachers, our spiritual health declines. Bob Schuchts explains:

The greatest poverty in the world is spiritual poverty. When children are not introduced to Jesus early in life, they fill themselves with the garbage of the world. Even children growing up in nominally Christian homes are often starving to know the truth. What a tragedy that even in many Catholic schools today, Jesus and his teaching are not the focal point (Schuchts 25).

A good teacher is one that teaches truth, is a faithful witness of the Gospel, and lives in Christ by practicing what is taught. One loving act from a teacher can radically impact a person's life. Take a moment to consider which teachers in your life most represented Jesus to you.

- Did any teachers help you get back on track in your life? How?
- Which teachers helped awaken your passions, interests, and God's calling in your life?
- Which teachers were good role models, by living what they taught?

Dear Parishioners,

It is the third and final day of the priest convocation. Each year, the priests of our diocese gather for three days down in Avalon. A speaker usually gives us talks on Monday night and Tuesday morning. The priests celebrating significant anniversaries (40, 50, and 60 years) are recognized and one of them preaches at Mass the second day. On the final day, the bishop addresses all the priests in something like a "state of the diocese" address. At the final Mass, one of the recently ordained priests is invited to preach. In between, the priests have the chance to be together in prayer (especially praying the liturgy of the hours together), over meals, and in recreation (this year I enjoyed a long walk with some brother priests and a fun game of soccer - the teams were "Team Sullivan" and "Team Williams" after our two bishops.)

One thing the speaker said at the beginning of his first talk was a quote from St John Vianney, the patron saint of priests. One time he told a bishop that if he wanted his diocese to be renewed in its love of God and neighbor, ALL of its priests needed to be holy. The speaker later said it is difficult to measure holiness, but he did give us a list of areas to consider. Some I remember were closeness to God in prayer, bearing crosses patiently, letting go of past hurts, and gratitude. I thank God to have priests in our own parish who show us "holiness" in various ways. On behalf of Fr Ted, Fr Len, and Fr Tony, I thank you for your prayers for us, which sustain and help us so much.

In this month of October, we are reminded of our "call" as Catholics to pray the Rosary. St John Paul II called it "the perfect prayer." Our Lady of Fatima urged us to pray it every day for world peace. As this election approaches, I encourage you to do all we are encouraged to do as Catholics and citizens - properly forming our consciences by reading the Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church, both of which show the beauty of God's plan for the flourishing of individuals and society. At the same time, I encourage each of you to pray the rosary (maybe beginning with one decade a day) to entrust our nation, world, families and selves into the loving and MOST ABLE hands of God and our Blessed Mother.
