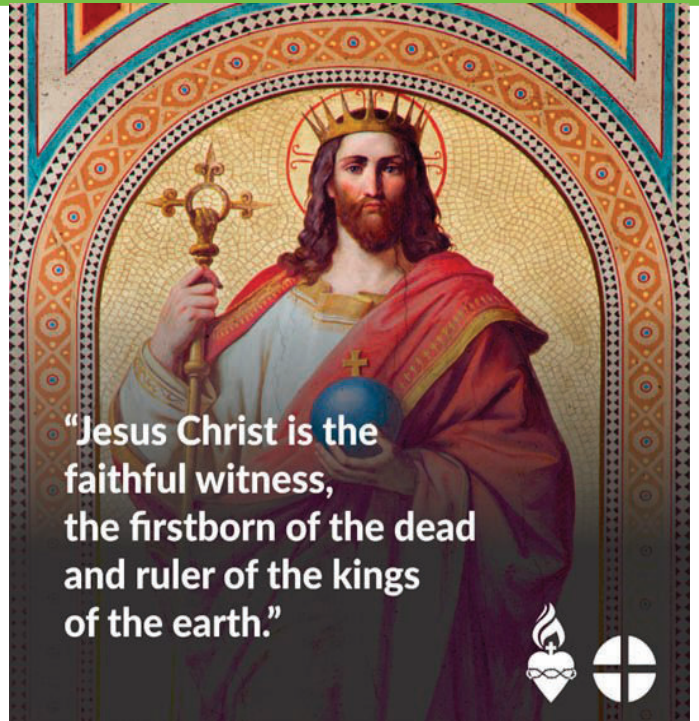

Bring the baby Jesus figurine from your home nativity set for blessing

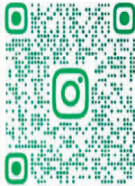
