# Something from the Pastor

October is a month dedicated to Mary, particularly, Our Lady of the Rosary. Praying the Rosary is an important practice in our growth in faith, hope and love. The twenty mysteries help us to gaze upon the life of Jesus, allowing us to know him better and follow his example. The Rosary helps us to live in his grace.

The first mystery of the Rosary is the Annunciation. Here, not only do we call to mind the conception of our Lord, which is joyous news, but also call to mind Mary's participation in our redemption. Mary's yes to the Saint Gabriel's message, begins to bring about our salvation as the Divine Son becomes Incarnate in her womb. He comes in the flesh to offer his flesh as a sacrifice for us.

Recall that after the Archangel's salutation (which we pray as the first half of the Hail Mary), Saint Luke relates Mary's shock and wonderment, stating: "But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be" (Luke 1:29).

This joyous news ought to elicit a similar response. The love of God shocks us and we too should ponder God's revelation to us. Mary pondered in faith, seeking a further understanding of God's revelation. Her pondering did not end after her encounter with the Archangel; she pondered until such time as she was assumed into heaven. Mary's constant pondering led her to desire the goodness of God and to profoundly love Jesus; loving her as her Son, as her God; loving Him in all his members.

When we devoutly pray the Rosary, we gaze upon Jesus with the eyes of Mary, learning from her how to treasure our Lord's life within our hearts. This leads us to be transformed by His grace, so to live as disciples of Christ.
