## *Something from the Pastor*

### ***Happy Easter!***

After 40 days of penance, to prepare for the Lord's passion, we now have 50 days of celebration of the Lord's resurrection. So, enjoy that Easter Candy!

Saint Luke relates in the Acts of the Apostles: "After his passion Jesus had presented himself alive to them by many proofs. He appeared to them during forty days and spoke to them about the kingdom of God" (Acts 1:3).

Walk with the risen Lord over these next few weeks, learning about the Kingdom of God. Take time every day to meditate upon the kingdom of God. This is done by praying with the teachings of Jesus as related in the Gospels. Prayerfully read and meditate upon the Sermon on the Mount and parables about the Kingdom. Take that time to ponder the resurrection and eternal life. Such meditation will prepare your heart for the out pouring of the Spirit on Pentecost.

Jesus still appears to us, as he comes to us in that mysterious way in the Eucharist: Jesus truly present, body, blood, soul and divinity. We receive Jesus into our very souls as we receive him in Holy Communion. Reception of Holy Communion is a foretaste of heaven, strengthening us to live as citizens of the Kingdom of God. We are filled with the Holy Spirit so to practice the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

As we prepared for the Triduum and Easter by prayer, fasting and giving of alms, let us prepare for the Pentecost in a similar way. At the end of the first 40 days of Easter, join us for the Novena to the Holy Spirit (May 15-23).

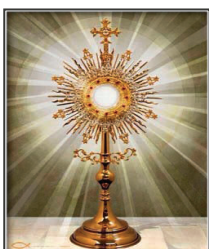

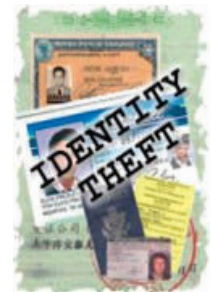


