## *Something from the Pastor*

With school coming to an end, and the official start of summer just around the corner, many are looking forward to that summer rest. Oddly enough, most of us will find ourselves busy running here and there, starting, and hopefully, completing various projects, while planning and executing vacations and trips. We might ask: where is the rest and leisure we associate with summer? We can get so busy with things that we never take the time to actually rest!

Jesus gives us an example of the type of rest that we all need. Saint Luke relates that Jesus “retired into the desert, and prayed” (Luke 5:16). Some translations recount that Jesus frequently did this, as is attested to elsewhere in the Gospel accounts. Jesus often went to deserted places to pray; that is, Jesus went to quiet places to pray. This sets an example for all of us. It is important to find those peaceful places and times we can sit quietly, undisturbed and pray.

Trying to create such a place in your home; a place away from the noise of others, with no tablets, phones, computers or TVs. A place that allows you to rest by reaching your heart and mind to God. A time and place where you can prayerfully ponder the scriptures, meditate upon the mysteries of the rosary or attentively pray the Lord’s Prayer. It can be in your garden or a quiet corner of your room.

Another excellent place to rest is before the Blessed Sacrament. Take advantage of the Holy Hour every Wednesday evening from 6:30 till 7:30, even if it is only for part of the hour. Adore the Lord in his Sacramental presence, spending time with your soul’s true love. It can become one of the best hours of the week!

Sanit Thomas Aquinas, drawing on the teaching of Aristotle, noted that “wisdom and knowledge come from repose”. We do not gain wisdom when we are agitated and busy about the various tasks of living. Rather, it is when we are at rest that we gain insight into truth, goodness and beauty, which then leads to true human flourishing. Time spent in prayer, particularly before the Blessed Sacrament, leads us to rest in God, which leads to living in the Spirit, producing the fruits of peace and kindness. Fruits that truly refresh the world.

Enjoy the summer and take some time to rest in the Lord; doing so will produce a truly fruitful summer.

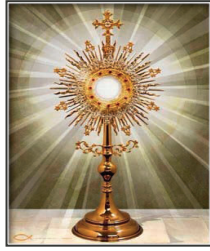

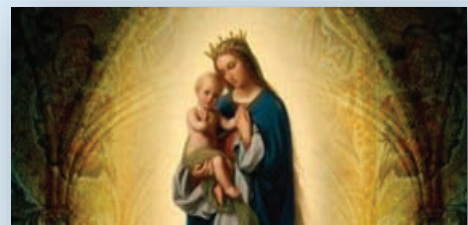
