The Pope's prayer intention for the month of July is for respect for human life. Let us pray for the respect and protection of human life in all its stages, recognizing it as a gift from God.

Something from the Pastor

We are half way through the summer (if you take summer to be the time between the end and the beginning of the school year). Summer is certainly a time of leisure and rest for many of us, even if it is just a few days down at the Jersey Shore.

Yet, leisure, that is a break from manual labor, is to be part of our lives, at least weekly. Recall the precept: Keep holy the Sabaoth, or the Lord's Day, (cf. Exodus 20:8). A day of rest. A day of true leisure, taking time to ponder God, His love for us, eternal life and how we journey there, goodness, truth and beauty. A day to gather with family and friends to share the good life, to refresh and encourage. Such reflection begins with worshipping God as community around the altar of the Lord.

Too often we make Sunday, the Lord's Day, to be a day for chores and even work; a day to run around from one event to another, rather than a day to slow down and rejoice with family and friends in the goodness of God. I encourage all of us to strive to keep the Lord's Day holy, that is separate from other days.

It is also important to slow down during the week for the same purpose. A wonderful way to slow down is to come to the Wednesday evening holy hour, even if just for a few minutes. To spend some time adoring the Eucharistic Presence of Jesus. During adoration, for a few moments, we can begin to experience what Jesus has taught: "This is eternal life, to know you the one true God and Jesus Christ whom you sent" (John 17:3).

Incorporate some true leisure into your life. Doing so will lead to living well and eternal glory.

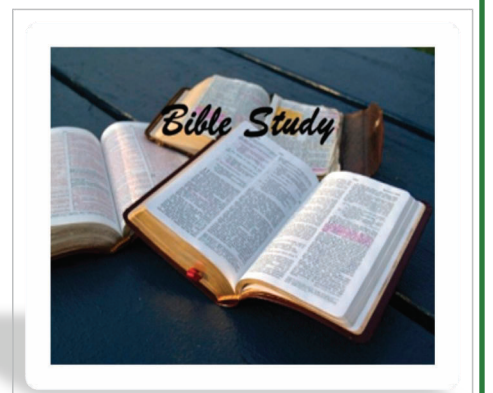

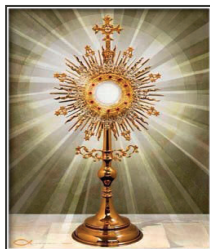

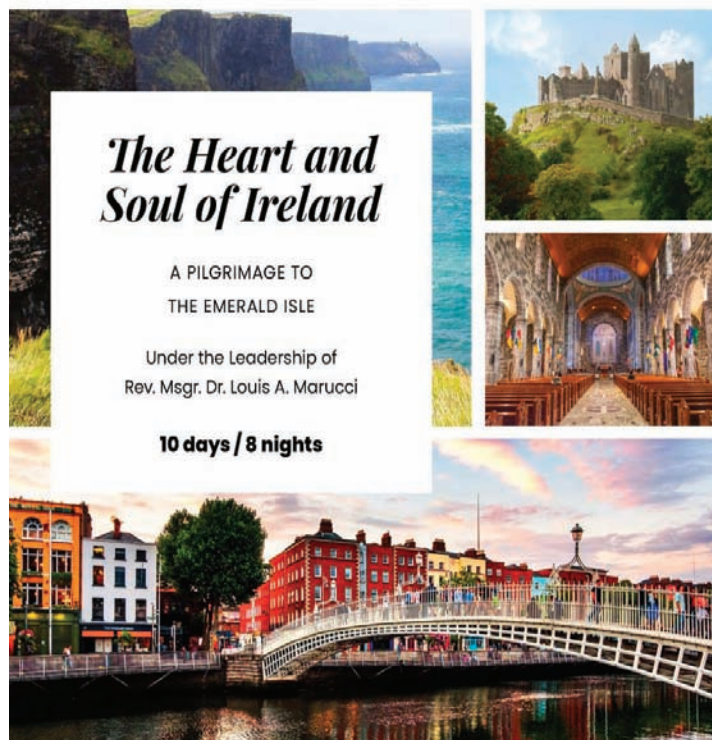
