

Miércoles de Ceniza

Iniciamos un camino de 40 días en busca del rostro del Señor. Según el Papa Benedito XVI, Hace referencia al tiempo de experiencia de fe del pueblo de Dios. Este periodo es de purificación y conversión. Nos preparamos para recibir gracias infinitas y bendiciones del cielo.

La imposición de las cenizas nos recuerda que somos polvo y al polvo volvemos, nos permite comprender que no somos dioses. Recordemos que Dios, está por encima del hombre.

No convirtamos la religión en simple formalismo. La imposición de la ceniza no puede ser un mero acto externo y un ritual, debe ser el inicio de una nueva vida. Nos ponemos la ceniza como símbolo de nuestro arrepentimiento y de que queremos ser nuevas creaturas. Hoy dejamos de vivir a espaldas a Dios y empezamos a obrar de cara a Él.

La iglesia nos propone tres caminos para alcanzar una autentica purificación. La oración, ayuno y limosna.

Oración: Jesús nos enseña que la oración debe ser breve en una sincera comunión personal con Dios, puesto que es para nuestro beneficio y no para el de Dios, ya que Él sabe lo que necesitamos. Debemos confiar que va a ser escuchada. San Agustín aconsejaba: "esfuérzate para que tu corazón vaya acompañando a las oraciones que vas diciendo en la oración. Que no sea un hablar sin ton ni son, si no que cada oración tuya sea un gemido, un suplicar protección, un pedir perdón, un querer que el Señor sea más glorificado y más amado y todo dicho con mucho amor a Dios.

Ayuno: Es la expresión de humillación ante Dios, los cristianos hacemos ayuno el miércoles de ceniza y los viernes. Este no es solo a la abstinencia de alimentos, también estamos llamados ayunar del pecado, chismes, rencores, intrigas, etc... El ayuno expresa el inmenso deseo de salvación. El verdadero ayuno se hace a los ojos de Dios y nunca a los ojos del hombre.

Limosna: Los Israelitas estaban convencidos que con la limosna se les reducían las deudas que tenían con Dios por sus pecados, pues el Arcángel San Rafael le dijo a Tobías: "La limosna borra muchos pecados" (Tobías 12,8). Recordemos que Dios no premia lo que hace sino con la intención con la cual la hacemos. Dios no nos cuenta cuantas hicimos o que tan grande hayan sido si no con cuanto amor la hicimos.

Hagamos estas preguntas: ¿Por quién estoy obrando?, ¿A quién busco agradar con mis obras y mis palabras?, ¿Por amor a quien estoy haciendo las obras que estoy realizando?

San Agustín señala que el ayuno y la limoná son las dos alas que le permiten a la oración tomar más fácilmente impulso y llegar hasta Dios.
