BAPTISM – Infants

1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 3:00 pm.

Parents should schedule their child's Baptism and attend the Prep Class as early in the pregnancy as possible.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Non-Catholics interested in becoming Roman Catholic and Catholics seeking to complete their initiation into the Church are invited to enroll in the OCIA – a religious formation program which introduces and explains the Catholic Faith to adults while preparing them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

CONFIRMATION – Adults

Catholics, ages 14 and older, who need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation should enroll in the *Adult Confirmation Program*.

HOLY MATRIMONY

Couples should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to the proposed wedding date. Either the bride or groom should be a registered parishioner.



GODPARENT/SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY

Those individuals seeking to become a godparent or sponsor in the Catholic Church must obtain from their parish a letter of eligibility. To receive such a letter one must fulfill the following conditions in the Diocese of Metuchen: Be at least 14 years of age, be a fully initiated member of the Church (having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist), if married, be in a valid Catholic marriage, be registered with a parish (for at least 6 months) and be actively practicing the faith (regularly attending Sunday Mass while living a life of Christian virtue and charity).

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK / HOMEBOUND

The sick, homebound and those scheduled for surgery are invited to call the parish office in order to make arrangements to receive Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Although the Sacrament of Anointing may be administered at any time during a serious illness, family members should not wait until the patient is in critical condition or unconscious before contacting a priest.

THE RENOVATION OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA CHURCH BEGINS!!

We are pleased to announce that the renovation of our church will officially begin on Sunday, June 14, 2026. It will consist of four phases:

- **THE ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING PHASE**

During this critical phase we will work with architects, engineers and other experts in developing a detailed projected plan. This includes getting permits and variances and obtaining bids from various contractors. This phase will begin immediately.

- **THE TRANSITIONAL PHASE**

During this phase we will make the necessary preparations for the temporary move of our liturgical services to the gym. This includes setting up the gym, creating a provisional sacristy and making arrangements with local parishes for the use of their churches for special liturgies such as weddings and funerals. This phase will begin after the new year with Masses starting in the gym after Easter.

- **THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE**

During this phase, the construction of the upstairs and downstairs church will take place. This phase will begin after Easter and continue until late Spring.

- **THE FINAL PHASE**

During this phase the church will be furnished and final inspections will take place with the rededication of the church on Saturday, May 13, 2028, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima.

To celebrate the official start of the renovation and give thanks to Almighty God, we will offer a Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, June 14th at 1pm. The main celebrant will be Fr. Jay Toborowsky, our diocesan administrator who is responsible for leading the Diocese of Metuchen while we await the appointment of a new bishop. All are welcome to join us for the Mass.

Following the Mass, a special reception will be held in the auditorium for all those who have made a pledge to our Capital Campaign. It is our simple way of thanking you for your support. Attending the reception will be Mr. Brian Doran, the head architect of the project, who will make a brief presentation and be available to answer any questions. We ask that those who receive an invitation, please RSVP by June 7th.

Please know that we will continue to accept pledges and donations during the renovation. We are almost at our target goal and will reach it with everyone's support. Thank you to all those who have already made a pledge. If you have not done so, please prayerfully consider making one today. Thank You.

STEWARDSHIP CORNER



Pentecost Sunday - May 24, 2026

[ACTS 2:1-11](#); [PS 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34](#); [1 COR 12:3b-7, 12-13](#); [JN 20:19-23](#)

Throughout our readings today for Pentecost Sunday, we see the powerful truth that the Holy Spirit gives us gifts and guidance in a deeply personal way. We are meant to use these gifts to build up the Body of Christ — each in our own unique way.

In our first reading from Acts, we hear of the dramatic outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. A strong driving wind filled the house, and tongues of fire came to rest on each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues.

Notice how personal this moment is. The Spirit came upon each individual, equipping them in a unique way to share the Gospel. The same is true for us today. Embracing the stewardship way of life means allowing the Holy Spirit to guide us in using the unique gifts He has given to each of us for the mission entrusted to us.

In our Gospel, Jesus sends His disciples forth: “As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” This is our mission as well. But we are not sent alone. Jesus gives us His peace — “Peace be with As this Easter season comes to a close, let us be at peace and resolve to rely more fully on the Holy Spirit as our guide through the stewardship way of life.

This program is available to unbaptized persons, baptized Christians from other faiths, and Catholics who have not received Confirmation and First Eucharist. If you are a non-Catholic interested in becoming Roman Catholic, or a Catholic seeking to complete your initiation into the Church, we invite you to enroll in the OCIA. To join us for an OCIA inquiry session please contact the Parish Office. There is no commitment to join the program when you attend an inquiry session. Joining the program does not mean that you have to become a Catholic. At the end of the program, individuals are free to choose to accept the sacraments or not.
