BAPTISM – Infants

1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 3:00 pm.

Parents should schedule their child's Baptism and attend the Prep Class as early in the pregnancy as possible.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Non-Catholics interested in becoming Roman Catholic and Catholics seeking to complete their initiation into the Church are invited to enroll in the OCIA – a religious formation program which introduces and explains the Catholic Faith to adults while preparing them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

CONFIRMATION – Adults

Catholics, ages 14 and older, who need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation should enroll in the *Adult Confirmation Program*.

HOLY MATRIMONY

Couples should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to the proposed wedding date. Either the bride or groom should be a registered parishioner.



GODPARENT/SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY

Those individuals seeking to become a godparent or sponsor in the Catholic Church must obtain from their parish a letter of eligibility. To receive such a letter one must fulfill the following conditions in the Diocese of Metuchen: Be at least 14 years of age, be a fully initiated member of the Church (having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist), if married, be in a valid Catholic marriage, be registered with a parish (for at least 6 months) and be actively practicing the faith (regularly attending Sunday Mass while living a life of Christian virtue and charity).

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK / HOMEBOUND

The sick, homebound and those scheduled for surgery are invited to call the parish office in order to make arrangements to receive Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Although the Sacrament of Anointing may be administered at any time during a serious illness, family members should not wait until the patient is in critical condition or unconscious before contacting a priest.

THE RENOVATION OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA CHURCH HAS BEGUN!!

We are pleased to announce that the renovation of our church officially began on Sunday, June 14, 2026. It will consist of four phases:

- **THE ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING PHASE**

During this critical phase we will work with architects, engineers and other experts in developing a detailed projected plan. This includes getting permits and variances and obtaining bids from various contractors. This phase is currently underway.

August Update: As we move forward with our church renovation, engineers, architects and other professionals will be working on site. As a result, there may be times during weekdays when the church will be unavailable for private prayer. However, know that our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel is always open and available for private and personal prayer. We thank you for your support and understanding and look forward with excitement to the future completion of our church renovation.

- **THE TRANSITIONAL PHASE**

During this phase we will make the necessary preparations for the temporary move of our liturgical services to the gym. This includes setting up the gym, creating a provisional sacristy and making arrangements with local parishes for the use of their churches for special liturgies such as weddings and funerals. This phase will begin after the new year with Masses starting in the gym after Easter.

- **THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE**

During this phase, the construction of the upstairs and downstairs church will take place. This phase will begin after Easter and continue until late Spring.

- **THE FINAL PHASE**

During this phase the church will be furnished and final inspections will take place with the rededication of the church on Saturday, May 13, 2028, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima.

Please know that we will continue to accept pledges and donations during the renovation. We are almost at our target goal and will reach it with everyone's support. Thank you to all those who have already made a pledge. If you have not done so, please prayerfully consider making one today. Thank You.

If you are a non-Catholic interested in becoming Roman Catholic, or a Catholic seeking to complete your initiation into the Church, we invite you to enroll in the OCIA. To join us for an OCIA inquiry session please contact the Parish Office. There is no commitment to join the program when you attend an inquiry session. Joining the program does not mean that you have to become a Catholic. At the end of the program, individuals are free to choose to accept the sacraments or not. STEWARDSHIP CORNER



August 30, 2026 – 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

[JER 20:7-9](#); [PS 63:2-6, 8-9](#); [ROM 12:1-2](#); [MT 16:21-27](#)

Living the stewardship way of life is not easy. Dying to self and living for Christ and others requires sacrifice. It is the work of a lifetime. Yet it is also the only work that truly matters and the only life that ultimately satisfies.

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells His disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross and follow me." At first, those words may sound difficult to accept. Why would anyone willingly embrace such a path?

Jesus immediately gives us the answer: "Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

Everything comes down to love. Jesus loved us completely, giving Himself for us on the Cross. He continues to give Himself to us through His Word and, most especially, in the Eucharist.

Each day we are faced with a choice: to live for ourselves or to live for God and for others. The second path is more demanding, but it leads to lasting joy and the promise of eternal life. Christ assures us that He "will come with his angels in his Father's glory and then he will repay all according to his conduct."

May we choose each day to lose our lives for Christ's sake, offering them back to Him in grateful response to His immeasurable love.

Pray the Holy Rosary with us Following Sunday Mass

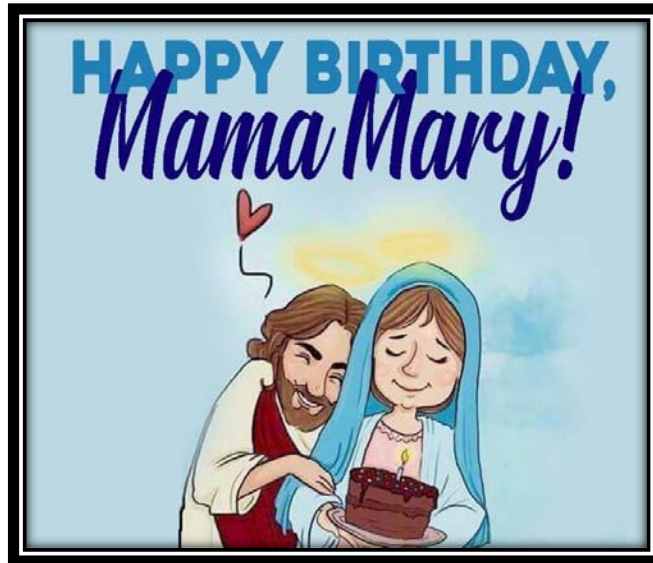
