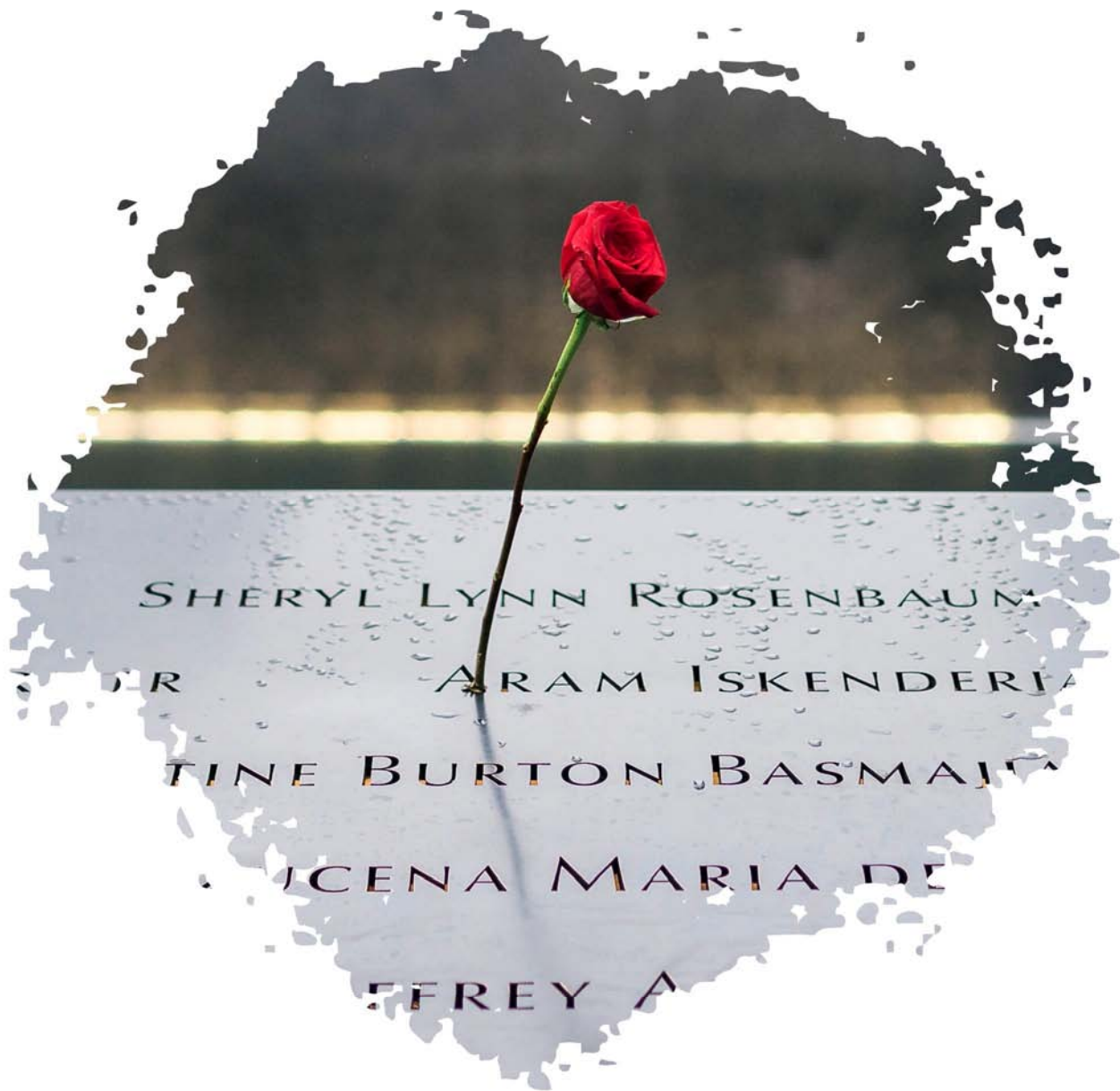

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION



September 13, 2026 – 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

[SIR 27:30-28:7](#); [PS 103:1-4, 9-12](#); [ROM 14:7-9](#); [MT 18:21-35](#)

Today's readings invite us to examine the state of our hearts — our thoughts, attitudes, and emotions. In our First Reading from Sirach, we hear about the destructive power of anger: "Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord?"

All of us have been hurt by others at some point, some more deeply than others. While our emotions are gifts from God, we are called to steward them well rather than allowing them to control us. How do we do that? Sirach gives us the answer: "Remember your last days, set enmity aside... Remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults." Instead of dwelling on past hurts, we choose gratitude. We remember God's countless blessings, His unfailing mercy, and His faithful love, placing our trust in Him.

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us of who we are before God through the parable of the unforgiving servant. A king forgives a debt so enormous it could never be repaid, yet the servant refuses to extend that same mercy to someone else.

The story should sound familiar. God has given us life, forgiven our sins through His Son, and opened the way to eternal life. We could never repay such a gift. The only fitting response is to offer Him our whole lives and to extend the same mercy and forgiveness He has shown to us.

That is the freedom and joy found in the stewardship way of life.

Psalm 33 is a great summary of the mission of the music ministry at OLF Parish. Our goal is to praise God and give thanks to the Lord through our music as well as enabling the congregation to do the same. We give the Lord our time, talents and best efforts to accomplish this as well as to help enhance the worship liturgy and enable the congregation to connect to God through music.

OCIA: The Order of Christian Initiation Of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who would like to become a Catholic? Are you a Catholic who would like to complete your initiation into the Church? The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) is a religious formation program which introduces and explains the Catholic Faith to adults while preparing them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. This program is available to unbaptized persons, baptized Christians from other faiths, and Catholics who have not received Confirmation and First Eucharist. If you are a non-Catholic interested in becoming Roman Catholic, or a Catholic seeking to complete your initiation into the Church, we invite you to enroll in the OCIA. To join us for an OCIA inquiry session please contact the Parish Office. There is no commitment to join the program when you attend an inquiry session. Joining the program does not mean that you have to become a Catholic. At the end of the program, individuals are free to choose to accept the sacraments or not. ***There will be an orientation meeting for interested teenagers (and their parents) who have not yet completed their initiation on September 26th.*** For more information contact Rose Fay at 732-325-8903. ***Classes begin Sunday, October 4th.***

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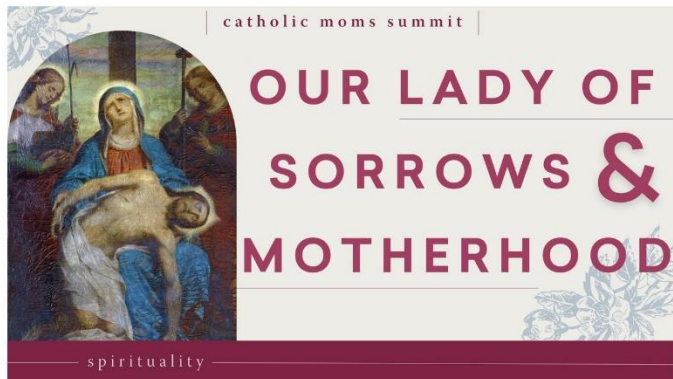
