## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES

The Religious Education program at St. Cecilia parish is committed to faith formation and formal training of children. The goal is to inspire and motivate children to develop love of the Father, have a personal encounter with Jesus Christ with guidance and knowledge of the Holy Spirit. We will build an understanding of the basic beliefs in the Roman Catholic faith and lay the foundation and encouragement to carry those beliefs to the community.

The preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation is incorporated over a period of three years for grades 6-7-8. Parish service hours are a sacramental requirement.

**Sponsors & Godparents:** The following are the mandated requirements to be a sponsor/Godparent at St. Cecilia parish:

- ✦ If married, the marriage MUST be valid within the Catholic Church
- ✦ At least 14 years of age
- ✦ Received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation in the Catholic Church
- ✦ Attend Mass regularly on Sundays (or Saturday evening) and Holy Days of obligation
- ✦ Receive the Sacrament of the Church regularly

Sponsors and Godparents must be an active parishioner and be attending Mass for at least 3 months to be eligible.






*Due to the restrictions placed on us because of the virus, the Bishop has decreed that Holy Communion will be distributed after Mass is completed.*






## Diocese Responds to “McCarrick Report”

Like Catholic dioceses across the nation and even around the world, the Diocese of Metuchen eagerly awaited the release of the Holy See’s findings of its investigation into disgraced former Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, founding bishop of the diocese. The report was published by the Holy See on November 10. ## How to Report Abuse

Sexual abuse by a priest, deacon or a staff member or volunteer of the Church should be reported, first to local law enforcement. If the abuse concerns a child, you can also notify the New Jersey Division of Child Protection and Permanency by calling 1-877-NJ ABUSE (652-2873) or 1-800-835-5510 (TTY/TDD for the deaf). The Child Abuse Hotline receives reports of child abuse and neglect 24-hours a day, 7 days a week. After notifying law enforcement, please notify the diocesan director of Child and Youth Protection, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by calling (908) 930-4558 or visiting [www.diometuchen.org/healing](http://www.diometuchen.org/healing) to report your abuse.

## Open Your Heart and Home to a Foster Child



Catholic Charities, Diocese of Metuchen is seeking loving families to foster children of all ages, who have been abused, neglected or have had multiple out of home placements, through its Treatment Family Homes Program, contracted by New Jersey’s Department of Children and Families.

The goal for the children in this program is to leave foster care and achieve permanency through reunification with their families, adoption, or independent living.

Catholic Charities provides these resilient children with individual and family therapy, assistance with educational and medical needs, and independent living skills to help them reach their full potential.

Applicants must have adequate space for a child and complete a home study which includes background checks, references, interviews, and a home inspection. All Catholic Charities licensed families receive initial and ongoing specialized training, 24 hour emergency access to staff, respite services, monthly reimbursement for the child’s expenses and support from experienced families.

## Volunteer to Make Pocket Rosaries for Law Enforcement

The Office of Family Life is pleased to announce the creation of the Blue Rosary Guild. The purpose of the Guild is for community members of all ages to make pocket Rosaries for law enforcement officers, providing them with support and spiritual strength and promoting devotion to the Rosary among all the faithful. All materials and instructions will be provided and a Zoom virtual tutorial will also be scheduled. ## Gluten Intolerance / Celiac Sprue

We know that those who live with gluten intolerance, especially Celiac Sprue disease, have special needs when it comes to receiving the Eucharist. Several parishioners have already spoken to us about this condition, and we have made special arrangements so that they are not deprived of receiving Jesus in Holy Communion.

Due to this condition, those affected are unable to receive the consecrated host at Communion because the gluten in the wafer would do damage to their small intestines and cause even potentially life-threatening conditions in the most serious cases. It is estimated that 1 in 133 people live with this condition, but the great majority - over 90% - are undiagnosed. 
