- ✦ Receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

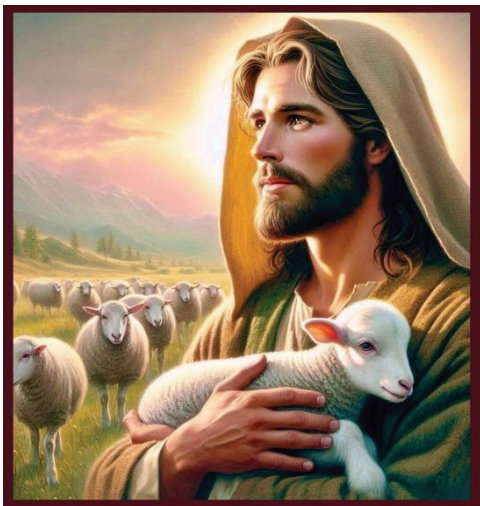

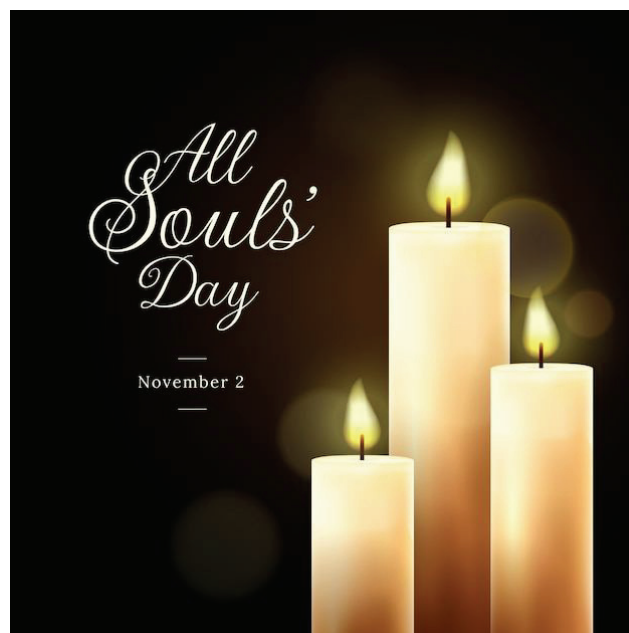

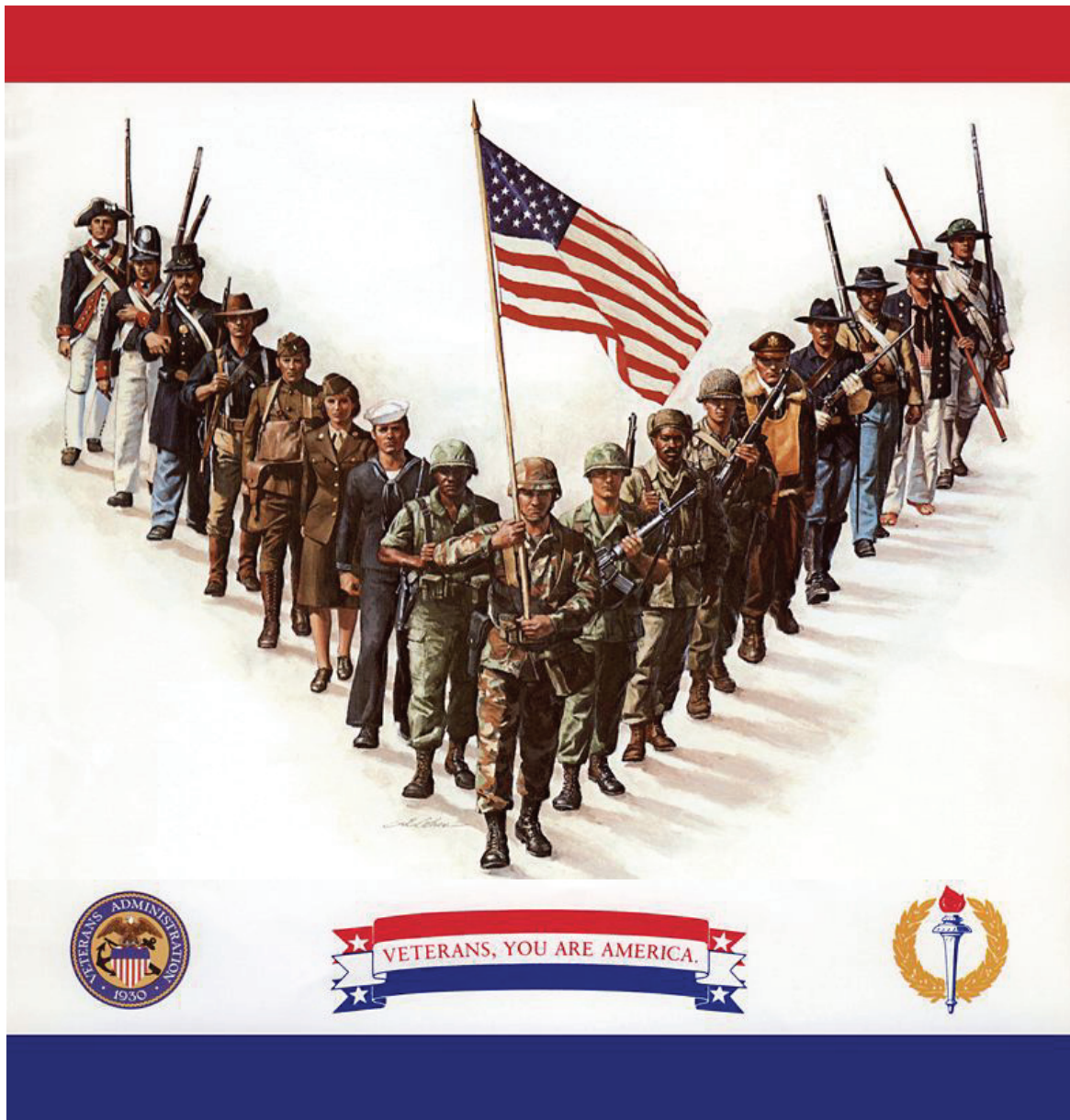

Veterans Day Mass

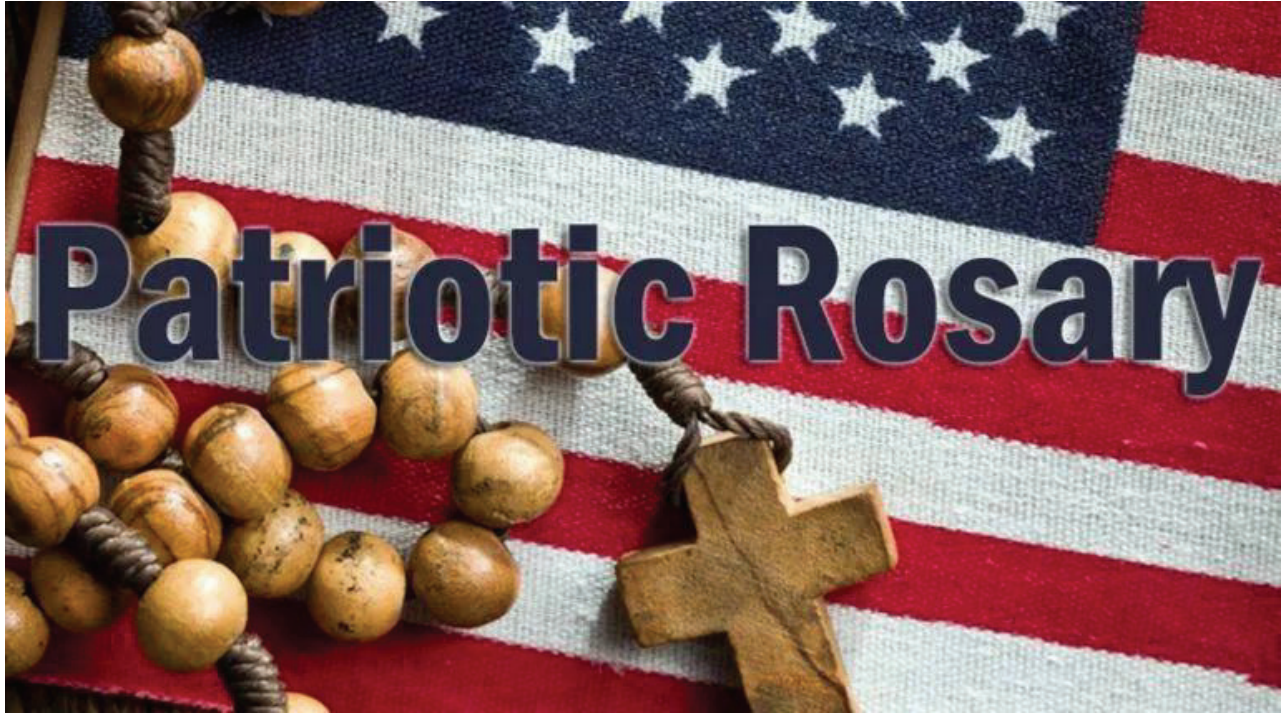
On Sunday, November 9, 2025

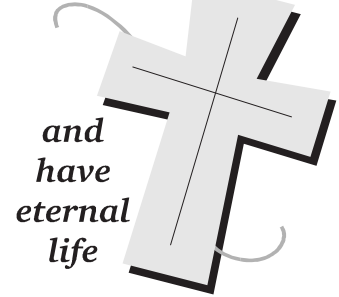

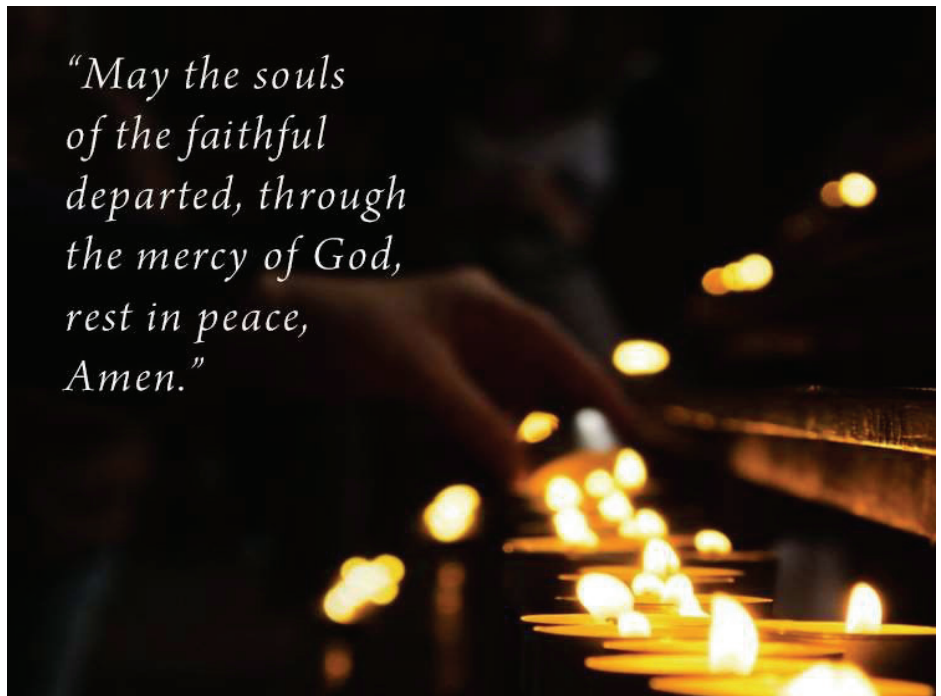
