There is a (3) month minimum registration requirement before registering for a baptism or requesting letters of eligibility/sponsorship. SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation **be an active**, **fully-initiated Catholic** (Confirmed). An **active** Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle and is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge or mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor). Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before their child's Baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on **the FIRST Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM.** Registration is required. Please contact Sr. Nadine 908-756-0633 x118 to register for the class or with any questions.



MISSION STATEMENT

In following with the Corporal Works of Mercy: Feed the hungry, Give drink to the thirsty, Clothe the naked, Shelter the homeless, Visit the sick, Visit the imprisoned, Bury the dead, Sacred Heart Social Concerns is a faith-based ministry serving the poor and those in need due to unforeseen circumstances, i.e., loss of employment, shelter, sickness, etc., with distribution of food and/or funds for utilities or housing. In keeping with the mission of Sacred Heart Parish, we are committed to being an instrument of healing and hope by ministering to those in need and celebrating Christ present in each of us.

ORGANIZATION

Membership in Sacred Heart Social Concerns consists of volunteers from the parishioners of Sacred Heart Church. Officers are President, Treasurer and Secretary. Meetings are held quarterly or as needed.

Monetary donations from the poor boxes, located at all Church doors, are deposited in the Social Concerns bank account. The money is used for those who qualify for financial help, and for purchasing needed food for the pantry.

All requests for food and financial assistance must be directed to extension 112 (the Social Concerns extension) on the Parish Center phone line 908-756-0633. Messages are reviewed every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday (except Holidays) between 9:00Am and 11:00AM by a member of Social Concerns.

Emergency food requests are provided once without question to anyone in need. If the request for food is for more than one time, the client will receive a phone call to set up an appointment at which time they will be asked to complete a personal and financial information form. The client will be interviewed by a two-member interview team to determine if the person or family can become a regular food client. To become a regular food client, a person (or family) should be a parishioner or a resident of South Plainfield. However, residents of surrounding communities may also be considered for assistance.

THIS IS OUR FAITH

Discipleship

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension, when Jesus returned to His heavenly Father. The last thing He told His disciples to do was: "Go then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

What does it mean to be a disciple? This word comes from the Latin word "discipulus," meaning learner. Two thousand years ago, being a disciple meant much more than our word student does today. Being a disciple was a state of life, but not merely in the sense of following another's ideas. The disciple gave up his entire life to be with his teacher. Back in those days, since teachers taught sitting down, a disciple would literally sit at his teacher's feet during the day, eat what and when his teacher ate, and slept when his teacher told him to. And the word disciple included the practice that the learner himself didn't just benefit from the teacher, the disciple was to share what they learned, bringing others into the community gathered around the teacher.

When Jesus uses the word disciple and instructs his current disciples to go out and make other disciples, He's telling them to do much more than communicate some basic academic ideas and concepts, which others may or may not accept. He's instructing them to bring others into this unique lifestyle. He's directing them to recruit others.

At different times in His public ministry, we know that Jesus was surrounded by crowds of followers, curiosity seekers, and believers. But all these people would not accurately be described as disciples. Disciples were a smaller group, a closer-knit community around Jesus. There were more than twelve of them but there weren't thousands either back then. Disciples were devotees of Jesus and learned from Him on a daily basis. They weren't taking a course of study with Him. This wasn't an academic endeavor. They were in a relationship with Jesus and He with them.

We see this clearly in the Acts of the Apostles. The early converts to Christianity were excited, highly motivated and changed how they were living their lives. They were close to one another in a community because it's always easier to maintain a new lifestyle if surrounded by likeminded others. In the Acts of the Apostles, we are given a description of what it meant to live as a disciple of Jesus (Acts 2:42-47). The lives of the early Christians entailed acts of charity, communal living and daily prayer.

So a disciple isn't merely someone who believes in Jesus and accepts His teachings in a casual way. A disciple is someone whose life is fundamentally changed in attitude, action, and perception of what their lives are all about. One could say that a closer synonym for disciple is the word apprentice. Jesus' last instruction to the Apostles was that they should go everywhere and recruit apprentices.

Would you consider yourself an apprentice of Jesus Christ? How do you sit at the Lord's feet today? Our lives are not communal ones and the practicalities of everyday life, such as work, mean we are not meeting daily for prayer and meals. But this doesn't mean that discipleship is irrelevant or an impossibility. Now, as then, apprenticeship means more than a casual interest in Jesus. As Catholics we're not merely collecting knowledge about Jesus. We are called to become like our Master. Our goal is to become like Jesus, acting as He acted, looking at the world the way He looked at the world, and recruiting others to be His disciples too. 







The Ascension
