## This Is Our Faith

### Divine Mercy Sunday

If you were Jesus, recently risen from the dead, what would you want to do most? You don't have much time before ascending to the Father in heaven. All four Gospels tell us that Jesus made a point of giving His disciples the mission to tell everyone about Him, making disciples in all the nations of the world. The Gospels also show that Jesus took some pains to prove that He was no ghost, but really, truly, physically resurrected. But there's one other thing He made sure to do.

In the Gospel of John, we read that Jesus came to His disciples, even though they were behind a locked door, showed the wounds on His hands and His side, and told them that He was sending them out to preach. Then something else happened: "He breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive people's sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven' " (John 20: 22-23). Although He could have done anything, Christ chose to extend God's mercy to us in this concrete way – through His apostles and their successors.

The gift of God's mercy is so important that Jesus made sure to enable us to have it whenever we regret the wrong that we have done. Through the sacrament of Reconciliation (also called Penance), we receive His forgiveness and His mercy. In this sacramental ritual we can have a transformative

experience. We can have God's healing of the rupture we have caused by the weaknesses we choose and the failures we deliberately select.

This great boundless mercy of the Father was emphasized most recently in the mid-twentieth century by St. Faustina. Between 1931 and 1938, St. Faustina Kowalski, a Polish nun, received visions and messages from Jesus about divine mercy. In 2000, Pope St. John Paul II officially declared the second Sunday in the Easter season Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast reminds us that when we repent of our sins and trust in the Lord, we will be forgiven.

Sometimes though, we have difficulty understanding how God can love us so much and extend His mercy to us so freely if He is also just. We can end up making a false distinction between God's mercy and His justice because we live in an unfair world and as human beings cannot imagine how God's justice and His generous mercy can coexist. We may think either that no matter what He forgives us and everyone ends up in heaven with Him or we may doubt that His justice can ever be met. Think of it this way: God's view is perfect assessment, not a matter of balancing the contrasts of consequences or compassion. That's the way human beings think. But God's way is not our way. Trust and repentance and His perfect assessment can be completely relied upon.
