Church law mandates that a sponsor for baptism and confirmation be an **active** Confirmed Catholic. An **active** Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (if married), and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Letters of eligibility can only be written for parishioners who meet these criteria. Mass attendance is normally confirmed by envelope use. Please call the parish office to obtain a sponsor letter or for additional information.
