GOD PARENT/SPONSOR LETTERS

Church law mandates that a sponsor for baptism and confirmation be an **active** Confirmed Catholic. An **ACTIVE** Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (if married), and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Letters of eligibility can only be written for parishioners who meet these criteria. Mass attendance is normally confirmed by envelope use. Please call the parish office to obtain a sponsor letter or for additional information.

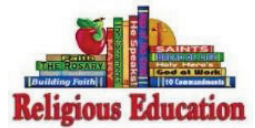
FAMILY MASS

Mass Intention Guidelines

The **2027 Book of Mass Intentions** opened on **Monday, June 22, 2026** in the Parish Office located at 18 South Street.

To accommodate the requests of many parishioners, we have implemented these guidelines for receiving Mass intention requests: Only six (6) mass intentions per parishioner will be allowed on the day of the mass book opening.

Once parishioners have had the opportunity for their initial six (6) Mass intentions, they are free to return beginning July 6, 2026 for additional requests. **Please keep in mind that only three (3) Sunday Masses are allowed per family per calendar year.**

Requesting a Mass:

- Anyone may request a Mass intention for:
 1. A person who is living or deceased, Catholic or non-Catholic.
 2. Intentions for a particular person/people.
 3. Intentions for members of a particular family/families
 4. A special intention appropriate to the celebration of the Eucharist eg: World Peace, Vocations, Respect for Life, Souls in Purgatory, etc. **These intentions should be general and not specific to an individual.**
- Each parish family is allowed up to ten (10) scheduled mass intentions (up to 3 of these can be Sundays) in a calendar year.
- Only 1 Mass per day can be prayed for any individual intention.
- No mass will be reserved in the book without a stipend of \$10.00
- There is no limit on Unannounced Mass requests. These masses are available at any time and are sent to the Office of Missions of the Diocese of Metuchen for a donation of \$10.00.
- Masses are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Phone or email requests along with the proper offering will be accepted by the parish office after July 6, 2026.
- One Mass every Sunday is scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as “ProPuolo” (for the Living and Deceased Members of Immaculate Conception Church).
- Mass intentions cannot be scheduled for Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter Sunday (including vigil), Mother’s Day, Father’s Day, All Saint’s Day, All Souls Day, Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. These masses will be celebrated for the general intentions of our parish.
- Church governance requires that only one intention (person) per Mass is allowed. However, for pastoral concerns and to better accommodate the needs of parishioners we will adhere to the following: Up to three first names with the same last name (i.e. John, Paul and Mary Smith) or two last names only (i.e. Jones and Smith Families) will be allowed per intention.

Changes and Cancellations:

- Once an intention has been added to the calendar, requests to change the date/time will not be accepted.
- When public mass is cancelled due to inclement weather the Mass intention will be celebrated privately.
- If a Mass is cancelled due to other unforeseen circumstances, the intention for the Mass will be rescheduled on the next available date.
- The pastor reserves the right to reschedule a Mass intention due to unforeseen parish conflicts.
