GOD PARENT/SPONSOR LETTERS

Church law mandates that a sponsor for baptism and confirmation be an **active** Confirmed Catholic. An **active** Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (if married), and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Letters of eligibility can only be written for parishioners who meet these criteria. Mass attendance is normally confirmed by envelope use. 


All are invited to join the Immaculate Conception Right to Life group for an outdoor rosary on the convent lawn on Saturday, June 14th at 12 noon.

What is a National Eucharistic Revival?

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years. Almost a hundred thousand Catholics will join together in Indianapolis for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the “source and summit” of our Catholic faith.


