Dear Parish Family,

Christ is Risen, Alleluia!
He is truly Risen, Alleluia!

Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!! By his death and Resurrection, Jesus has destroyed sin and death forever! And he has done it, not by brute force and violence, but by being the Suffering Servant who willingly laid down his life so that we and every creature loved into life by God could have that life forever. UPGRADE TO OUR CHURCH SOUND SYSTEM COMING!

We have been having increasing problems with our church sound system since it was installed in 2012.

Major declines occurred right after COVID. Several people have commented to me that they can’t clearly hear the lectors, priest, or cantor at Mass. So I invited Monte Brothers, Sound Systems Inc., located in Dobbs Ferry, NY, who are perhaps the most popular name in installing and upgrading sound systems in churches and institutions throughout the United States, to look at our sound system. It definitely needs an upgrade.

They came up with a proposal that will greatly benefit the sound in the church and choir loft, but as with everything you purchase today, it is costly. **Approximately \$90,000.**

Our parish Finance Committee reviewed the proposal and unanimously approved the project. We will be using some of the rebate money from this year’s Annual Catholic Appeal to help pay for the cost, but I am humbly asking **if any parishioner or friend of Saint Rose Parish would like to make a donation for the new sound system, it will be greatly appreciated. Please send your donation to me directly by placing it in the collection basket or drop it off at the parish office.**

One of the best investments a parish can make is in its sound system because the Word of God is proclaimed at every Mass! “Faith comes by hearing,” St. Paul says, and we all need to hear the Good News of the Gospel clearly. Thank you and God bless you for any assistance you can offer!



Each year on the **Second Sunday of Easter (next week, April 12th)** the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday.**

In the 1930’s, Jesus chose a humble nun, Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning Divine Mercy that are recorded in her Diary.

St. Faustina’s Diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that the Feast of Mercy be observed. On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

As part of the special celebration of this Feast of Divine Mercy, we will have **Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament at 3:00 p.m., the hour of Great Mercy.**

The Chaplet will be **sung**, followed by the Litany of Divine Mercy, and the Blessing of the Image of Divine Mercy. Mass will be celebrated at 5:00 p.m.

The Feast of Mercy is the focal point that summarizes the Divine Mercy message and devotion made known to St. Faustina—to literally loosen the floodgates of God’s Mercy on this day. Jesus promises unfathomable graces on that day to souls that will go to confession before and receive Him worthily in Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy (see *The Diary of St. Faustina*, #699).

We are living in difficult and disturbing times when we need to pray for souls and beg God’s mercy upon our world.

As Jesus revealed to St. Faustina, **“Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of Mercy.”**

“Yes, Christ is truly risen, and we are witnesses of this. We proclaim this witness to the world, so that the joy which is ours will reach countless other hearts, kindling in them the light of the hope which does not disappoint.”

(St. John Paul II, 2000)

Enjoy your Easter celebrations today with family and friends, and may God bless you and keep you always in His Love!

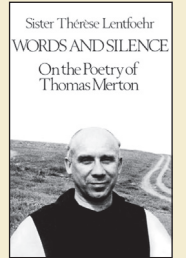
