OUR SACRAMENTAL LIFE

BAPTISM — Schedule by contacting the office at least four months in advance. Parents are asked to attend a pre-baptism conference; godparents also are welcome to attend.

MATRIMONY — At least a year prior to your anticipated date, contact the office for information on the preparatory process.

RCIA — The Rite of Christian Initiation is offered year round for adults who seek to join the Catholic Church or for those Catholics who wish to complete their sacramental initiation (First Communion and/or Confirmation). Weekly classes begin each September.

MINISTRIES TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND — In case of serious illness, contact the office to arrange for the anointing of the sick. Contact the office also to arrange for regular visits to the homebound for the reception of Holy Communion.

SACRAMENTS FOR CHILDREN — The Religious Education Office can arrange the preparation for older children or teens who wish to receive First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS — We provide low-gluten (0.01%) hosts for those with Celiac Disease. Please inform the priest or deacon of your need prior to the celebration of Mass; at communion time, approach the priest celebrant who will have this sacred host.

MASS INTENTIONS — The usual offering is \$10.

ASKED TO BE A GODPARENT/SPONSOR? — Certificates of eligibility are provided to registered parishioners who meet the qualifications established in Canon Law. A Godparent/Sponsor is a Catholic who has received the Eucharist and Confirmation; lives a life in harmony with the Catholic Faith; (if married) is in a marriage recognized as valid by the Church; and is not the parent of the one to be baptized or confirmed.

Dear Parishioners:

Yet again, I wish to express my thanks to you for remembering the needs of the parish during this COVID-19 period. The contributions we receive in church, on-line, by mail, or by personal delivery are greatly appreciated.

WHAT ARE CATHOLICS TO THINK

...of the defacing and toppling of the statues of this Franciscan Saint whose feast we celebrated July 1?



The Catholic Bishops of California issued the following statement [here abridged] on June 22, 2020:

The movement to confront racism within our society during these past weeks has been...challenging but it has provided...new hope...that our nation can begin to transform key elements of our racist past and present. We vigorously and wholeheartedly support a broad national coalition...in its peaceful dedication to eliminating racism against members of the African American and Native American communities.

[T]he specific question of removing statues of political, military, and cultural leaders of the past has gained momentum. If this process is to be truly effective as a remedy for racism, it must discern carefully the entire contribution that the historical figure in question made to American life, especially in advancing the rights of marginalized peoples.

In calling for the removal of images of St. Junipero Serra from public display in California, and in tearing down his statue in San Francisco and Los Angeles, protesters have failed that test. As Archbishop Cordileone pointed out:

“St. Serra made heroic sacrifices to protect the indigenous people of California from their Spanish conquerors, especially the soldiers. Even with his infirmed leg which caused him such pain, he walked all the way to Mexico City to obtain special faculties of governance from the Viceroy of Spain to discipline the military who were abusing the Indians. And then he walked back to California. And lest there be any doubt, we have a physical reminder to this day: everywhere there is a presidio (soldiers’ barracks) associated with a mission in the chain of 21 missions that he founded, the presidio is miles away from the mission itself and the school. St. Junipero Serra also offered them the best thing he had: the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ, which he and his fellow Franciscan friars did through education, health care, and training in the agrarian arts. The historical truth is that Serra repeatedly pressed the Spanish authorities for better treatment of the Native American communities. Serra was not simply a man of his times. In working with Native Americans, he was a man ahead of his times who made great sacrifices to defend and serve the indigenous population and work against an oppression that extends far beyond the mission era. And if that is not enough to legitimate a public statue in the state that he did so much to create, then virtually every historical figure from our nation’s past will have to be removed for their failings measured in the light of today’s standards.”

Our Summer Project

Over the last eight years, our annual summer project has proven to be a great help to maintaining the two campuses of our parish. This year our project goal is different in that we are proposing a "two-year plan" since we are eyeing two necessary and rather costly upgrades: the replacement of the school boiler and the air conditioning units of St. Anthony Church. Both have reached an "age" that require extensive repairs and the parts needed to make them are very difficult to obtain or no longer available. We have been advised that it would be wiser to replace them. New units would be energy efficient.

Our finance and pastoral councils have endorsed the idea of dedicating funds of both the 2020 & 2021 Summer Projects to help finance these expensive and necessary projects. Funds raised over the next two years will be set aside until the work must be done.

In past years, I suggested a gift of \$100 but I realize many parishioners are dealing with financial hardships in this COVID-19 time. Any gift you can make would be most welcome. The appeal runs from July 1 through September 1. In the next few weeks, you should receive details of the appeal in the mail.


