FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

The readings of today's Mass highlight "vocation," that is, one's calling from God. We hear of God's call to Samuel, who was prompt to serve the Lord. The Gospel recounts the call to John and Andrew. These apostles were not called directly by the Lord but through an intermediary, their teacher, John the Baptist. In turn, Andrew becomes an intermediary and goes to his brother, Simon Peter and "brought him to Jesus."

Every Christian is called—in a way suited to his or her state of life—to follow Christ in holiness and through an apostolate. More often than not, God uses intermediaries to bring one to the light of a vocation. He may use us to invite someone to consider a particular vocation. This is very important when we consider the vocation to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life.

Have we ever identified someone who might be a good future priest, deacon, or religious? The power of personal invitation cannot be overstated. A national survey a few years ago found that those who had one person encouraging them were nearly twice as likely to consider a religious vocation as those who were not encouraged. Those encouraged by more people were even more likely to consider such a vocation.

However, to encourage someone to consider such a vocation, we must ourselves be convinced of its necessity, value, and importance. Priests, Deacons, and Religious must do their part to convey the joy and satisfaction they experience in living it.

While God is surely the One who calls, He may use us as His instruments to help bring a flowering of vocations for the Church. Let us pray, identify, encourage potential vocations, and invite many to "come and see" how wonderful it could be to serve the Lord through His Church.

A weekly excerpt from the book, Joseph the Silent by Michel Gasnier, O. P.

What the Holy Spirit wrought for her, He wrought for both of us.’”



Whether you registered as a parishioner seven years ago or seven times seven years ago, things change. Your household grows as you welcome babies; it shrinks as your adult children move out to pursue a career. Elderly parents may move in with you or someone in your family may need to be moved to a skilled nursing care facility. You may upsize or downsize, moving within or out of the parish boundaries.

We care about the changes in your life, so please keep us informed if one of your loved ones is hospitalized or moves into assisted living or a nursing home. Let us know when you're moving—we may not join your painting party, but we will update our records.

And please explain to your children that once they're out of your home and living independently, they need to register on their own. This is a simple task but is very helpful when they request a letter of eligibility to serve as a sponsor for baptism or confirmation, or a letter of reference or recommendation.

A BAPTISM PRIMER



Baptism is...

- the gateway to the sacraments
- necessary for salvation by actual reception or at least by desire
- conferred by washing of blessed water & proper form of words
- to be conferred without delay in danger of death

The Baptized are

- freed from all sin
- reborn as children of God & heirs of heaven
- configured to Christ by an indelible character
- incorporated into the Church
- to be given a name that is not offensive to Christian sensibilities
- as adults, must intend to be baptized and be catechized
- when adults, to receive the Eucharist & Confirmation

The celebration of Baptism

- must take place in a church or oratory, not a private house
- may take place in a hospital “in danger of death”
- may be by immersion or pouring of water
- may be on any day but is recommended on Sundays or Easter Vigil
- should ordinarily take place in one’s proper parish

The Minister of Baptism

- is a bishop, priest, or deacon
- may in emergency be anyone person with the proper intention & proper words
- must have permission of pastor to baptism outside of his parish

Parents

- must care that infants are baptized in the first few weeks after birth
- are to be prepared for the baptism properly by the parish
- manifest the founded hope that the infant will be raised in the Catholic faith

Sponsors

- help the baptized to live a Christian life in keeping with baptism
- may be only one male or one female or one of each *
- must be Catholic, at least 16 years of age
- must have received the Holy Eucharist & Confirmation
- must lead a life in harmony with the Catholic faith
- if married, must be in a union recognized as valid by the Church
- may not be the parent(s) of the one to be baptized
- may also serve as the sponsor for the baptized at his/her Confirmation

*A person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may not be a sponsor but may be admitted as a “Christian Witness” along with the Catholic sponsor.




