





PROMISE TO PROTECT—PLEDGE TO HEAL

Our Diocese is committed to the norms of the US Bishop's Charter for the Protection of Children & Youth regarding the reporting and investigation of sexual abuse allegations involving minors. If you have been sexually abused as a minor by anyone representing the Catholic Church, or if you know of someone who was, you can report the abuse: Hotline: 1-888-296-2965 or via e-mail at abuseline@dioceseoftrenton.org. Such allegations are reported to the appropriate law enforcement agencies.

CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM—Parents are encouraged to baptize their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office a few months in advance. A pre-baptism instruction is required for first time parents.

MATRIMONY—Contact the office prior to reserving the reception venue. Marriage preparation should begin at least a year prior to the wedding date.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA) is offered year-round for those seeking to be received into the Church and those Catholics who wish to complete their sacramental initiation (First Communion and/or Confirmation).

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND—The Anointing of the Sick should be arranged for the seriously ill. Regular visits for Holy Communion may also be arranged.

LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS (0.01%)—These are provided for those with Celiac Disease. Please inform the priest or deacon of your need prior to Mass. At Communion time, approach the priest celebrant, who will have this Host.

DEVOTIONS

THURSDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION—follows the 9:00 AM Mass at Our Lady of Sorrows through 6:00 PM. Funerals may interrupt the time of adoration. Consult the office.

MORNING PRAYER (Lauds) — Monday – Friday at 6:30 AM; Saturdays at 8:35 AM; Sundays at 7:30 AM

PRAYERS FOR THE SICK —Names of the sick may be placed on the bulletin's "Prayer List." Please obtain the person's permission.

AT YOUR SERVICE

REGISTRATION—New parishioners are welcome. Registration can be made online or in person at the office. This enables the parish to verify your contributions and provide letters of recommendation.

IF I DON'T RECEIVE FROM THE CHALICE....

Is something "lost" with the reception of the Sacred Host alone? While Holy Communion under both species provides a "fuller sign" of the Eucharistic mystery, the Lord Jesus is "fully present" under each species. This is called the doctrine of "concomitance."



St. Thomas Aquinas teaches: "Nothing is lost by the body being received by the people without the blood: because the priest both offers and receives the blood in the name of all, and the whole Christ is present under either species." (Summa Theologiae, III, q. 80, a. 12, ad 3).

The Catechism states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." (#1390)

The U.S. Bishops remind us that "it should never be construed...that Communion under the form of bread alone or Communion under the form of wine alone is somehow an incomplete act or that Christ is not fully present to the communicant. The Church's unchanging teaching...has witnessed to a constant unity of faith in the presence of Christ in both elements. Even in the earliest days of the Church's life, when Communion under both species was the norm, there were always instances when the Eucharist was received under only the form of bread or wine. The Church has always taught the doctrine of concomitance, by which we know that under each species alone, the whole Christ is sacramentally present, and we receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace."
