CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM—Parents are encouraged to baptize their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office a few months in advance. A pre-baptism instruction is required for first time parents.

MATRIMONY—Contact the office prior to reserving the reception venue. Marriage preparation should begin at least a year prior to the wedding date.

THE ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (OCIA) is offered year-round for those seeking to be received into the Church and those Catholics who wish to complete their sacramental initiation (First Communion and/or Confirmation).

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND—The Anointing of the Sick should be arranged for the seriously ill. Regular visits for Holy Communion may also be arranged.

LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS (0.01%)—These are provided for those with Celiac Disease. Please inform the priest or deacon of your need prior to Mass. At Communion time, approach the priest celebrant, who will have this Host.

REGISTRATION—New parishioners are welcome. Registration can be made online or in person at the office. This enables the parish to verify your contributions and provide letters of recommendation.

The pope is the sovereign of the order. The Order is an internationally recognized order of chivalry. Its primary mission is to support the Christian presence in the Holy Land. The Order today is estimated to have some 30,000 knights and dames around the world. The Grand Master is Fernando Cardinal Filoni. The Order's headquarters is at the Palazzo Della Rovere, Rome.

NOVEMBER MONTH OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

Holy Mother Church always encourages us to offer our prayers in suffrage for the souls in Purgatory. In fact, a long tradition dedicates the month of November for this laudable practice. Our ties with deceased relatives and friends do not end with their death. In the funeral homily for his father, Justice Antonin



Scalia, Fr. Paul Scalia reflected on the need for such prayer. What he said of his father could be said of our loved ones:

"We look to Jesus, in petition...as we mourn the one we love and admire, the one whose absence pains us. Today we pray for him. We pray for the repose of his soul. We thank God for his goodness Dad, as is right and just. But we also know that, although Dad believed, he did so imperfectly, like the rest of us. He tried to love God and neighbor but, like the rest of us, did so imperfectly. He was a practicing Catholic—practicing in the sense that he hadn't perfected it yet. Or, rather, that Christ was not yet perfected in him. And only those in whom Christ is brought to perfection can enter heaven. We are here then, to lend our prayers to that perfecting, to that final work of God's grace, in freeing Dad from every encumbrance of sin. ...Let us not show him a false love and allow our admiration to deprive him of our prayers. We continue to show affection for him and do good for him by praying for him: that all stain of sin be washed away, that all wounds be healed, that he be purified of all that is not Christ. That he rest in peace."

An Overview of Each Session

Session 1: What's Our Story? The Bible is the story of God's love for us. He created us out of love, redeemed us by his love, and transforms us in his love.

Session 2: Who Is Jesus? Jesus is both God and man, therefore he reveals who God is in relation to us. Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15) He asks this same question of us: who do you say Jesus is?

Session 3: Am I Saved? Salvation is a gift from God through Jesus Christ that requires our "yes."

Session 4: Why a Church? Jesus didn't simply leave us a written message or instruction manual to follow. He gave us a living, dynamic Church where we encounter him personally and allow ourselves to be transformed into his likeness.

Session 5: God Is with Us God's presence in the Old Testament foreshadows the gift of the Eucharist, one of the seven sacraments of the Church. Jesus established the Eucharist to give us strength and accompany us at every moment of our earthly journey.

Session 6: The Story of the Eucharist The story of the Eucharist can be traced throughout Scripture. From Genesis to the present day, this session explores how the Cross is the new Tree of Life, and the Eucharist is its fruit.

Session 7: Bread for the Journey The Eucharist sustains us on our spiritual journey. Our participation at Mass through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist is an offering of thanksgiving to God. We are then sent forth to share what we have received.
