PRAYERS FOR THE SICK —Names of the sick may be placed on the bulletin’s “Prayer List.” Please obtain the person’s permission.

CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM—Parents are encouraged to baptize their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office a few months in advance. A pre-baptism instruction is required for first time parents.

MATRIMONY—Contact the office prior to reserving the reception venue. Marriage preparation should begin at least a year prior to the wedding date.

THE ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (OCIA) is offered year-round for those seeking to be received into the Church and those Catholics who wish to complete their sacramental initiation (First Communion and/or Confirmation).

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND—The Anointing of the Sick should be arranged for the seriously ill. Regular visits for Holy Communion may also be arranged.

LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS (0.01%) are provided for those with Celiac Disease. Please inform the priest or deacon of your need prior to Mass. At Communion time, approach the priest celebrant, who will have this Host.

REGISTRATION—New parishioners are welcome. Registration can be made online or in person at the office. This enables the parish to verify your contributions and provide letters of recommendation.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners



In today's Gospel, we hear Our Lord's call to intimacy with him: "Remain in me...just as branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me." How appropriate this message as we celebrate next weekend the First Communion of our young parishioners!

Our Catholic Faith teaches us that the Eucharist is not just some 'thing,' a symbol, but Someone: Jesus Himself, really and truly present—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—under the form of bread and wine. If we truly believe this, we should want to receive him worthily and often. Deacon Clarence Enzler gives this moving description of the Sacrament:

"When you begin to understand the Eucharist...you will begin to comprehend the depths of my love for you. Look at the Host...a wafer of bread. Never were appearances so deceiving! The host is myself...healer of lepers, giver of sight...he who wept at Lazarus' grave, who asked drink of the Samaritan woman...who forgave the adulteress...the Teacher, the Savior...Can you think of a better way for me to give you spiritual sustenance? Do you not see the love that prompts your God...how zealously I work to bring you close to me? To give myself to you...I had to make myself unlike you. I hid myself under the likeness of common food because I did not want you to shrink from coming to me.

When I come to you in the Eucharist...I am in you! You are in me! In the Eucharist we become one flesh. You work not...alone, but I work in you. You serve others...not alone...I serve you. You suffer, not...alone, but I suffer in you. You adore me; you give thanks with me; you love with me; you live now, not yourself...but I live in you!"
