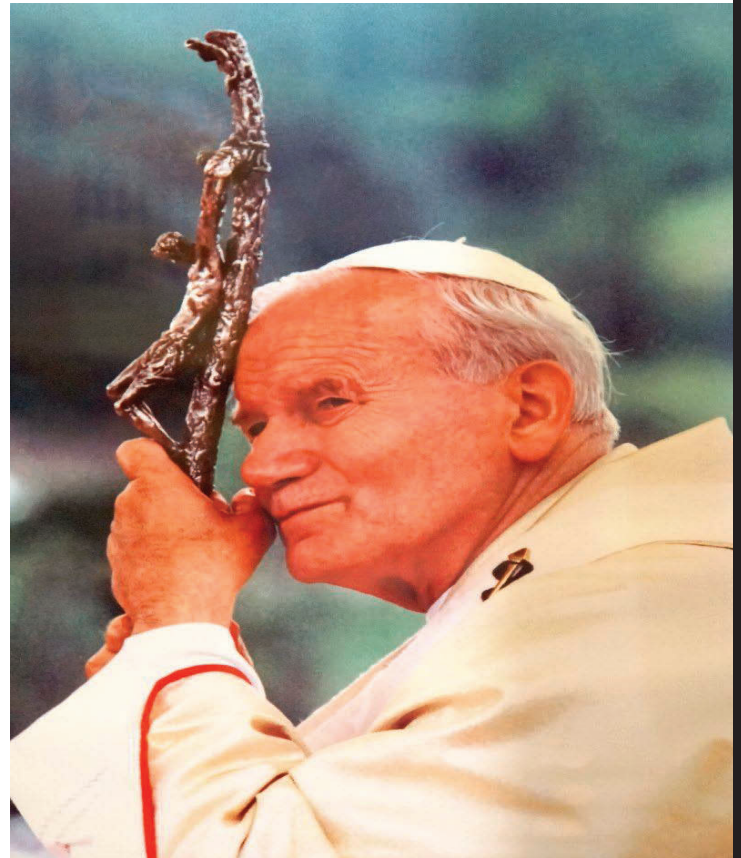

Parish Registrations – We kindly request that all those who attend mass register with the parish. Registration forms are available at the parish office or may be mailed to you.

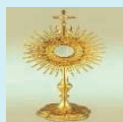

Youth Corner

Here's why John Paul II said "Do not be afraid"

On October 22, 1978, St. John Paul II was inspired by the Holy Spirit to urge Christians to conquer fear. Throughout his 26-year pontificate, one of St. John Paul II's most used phrases was, "Do not be afraid" (also phrased "Be not afraid").

Was that planned? How did it come about?

John Paul II reflected on that phrase in the book *Crossing the Threshold of Hope* and explained that it was the Holy Spirit who inspired him to say those words.

When, on October 22, 1978, I said the words "Be not afraid!" in St. Peter's Square, I could not fully know how far they would take me and the entire Church. Their meaning came more from the Holy Spirit, the Consoler promised by the Lord Jesus to His disciples, than from the man who spoke them.

He then continues the reflection and explains why he would often return to the phrase during his many years as pope.

The exhortation "Be not afraid!" should be interpreted as having a very broad meaning. In a certain sense it was an exhortation addressed to all people, an exhortation to conquer fear in the present world situation ... Why should we have no fear? Because man has been redeemed by God. When pronouncing these words in St. Peter's Square, I already knew that my first encyclical and my entire papacy would be tied to the truth of the Redemption. In the Redemption we find the most profound basis for the words "Be not afraid!": "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son" (cf. Jn 3:16).

Christians should not be afraid of any storm that may buffet them, for they have their hope in Jesus Christ, who came to save the world from darkness.

For St. John Paul II, nothing should take away our hope in the Lord. When we know that God is in control, and that he is love, our fears disappear.

*Peoples and nations of the entire world need to hear these words. Their conscience needs to grow in the certainty that **Someone exists who holds in His hands the destiny of this passing world ... And this Someone is Love.***

God is love, and if we truly understand that we no longer have fear of the "present world situation," even if it grows darker. God is love and he is in control.

He aquí por qué Juan Pablo II dijo: "No tengáis miedo"

El 22 de octubre de 1978, San Juan Pablo II fue inspirado por el Espíritu Santo para instar a los cristianos a vencer el miedo. A lo largo de sus 26 años de pontificado, una de las frases más utilizadas por San Juan Pablo II fue: "No tengas miedo" (también fraseada como "No tengas miedo").

¿Estaba planeado? ¿Cómo surgió?

Juan Pablo II reflexionó sobre esa frase en el libro **Cruzando el umbral de la esperanza** y explicó que **fue el Espíritu Santo quien lo inspiró a decir esas palabras.**

Cuando, el 22 de octubre de 1978, pronuncié las palabras "¡No tengáis miedo!" en la Plaza de San Pedro, no podía saber completamente hasta dónde me llevarían a mí y a toda la Iglesia. Su significado provenía más del Espíritu Santo, el Consolador prometido por el Señor Jesús a sus discípulos, que del hombre que las pronunció.

Luego continúa la reflexión y explica por qué a menudo volvería a la frase durante sus muchos años como Papa.

La exhortación "¡No tengas miedo!" debe interpretarse como que tiene un significado muy amplio. En cierto sentido fue una **exhortación dirigida a todos los pueblos, una exhortación a vencer el miedo en la situación mundial actual...** ¿Por qué no debemos tener miedo? Porque el hombre ha sido redimido por Dios. Al pronunciar estas palabras en la Plaza de San Pedro, ya sabía que mi primera encíclica y todo mi papado estarían ligados a la verdad de la Redención. En la Redención encontramos el fundamento más profundo de las palabras "¡No temas más!": "Porque tanto amó Dios al mundo que dio a su Hijo unigénito" (cf. Jn 3, 16).

Los cristianos no deben tener miedo de ninguna tormenta que pueda azotarlos, porque tienen su esperanza en Jesucristo, quien vino a salvar al mundo de las tinieblas.

Para San Juan Pablo II, nada debe quitarnos la esperanza en el Señor. Cuando sabemos que Dios tiene el control, y que él es amor, nuestros temores desaparecen.

*Los pueblos y las naciones de todo el mundo necesitan escuchar estas palabras. Su conciencia necesita crecer en la certeza de que existe **Alguien que tiene en sus manos el destino de este mundo pasajero... Y este Alguien es el Amor.***

Dios es amor, y si realmente comprendemos eso, ya no tenemos miedo de la "situación actual del mundo", incluso si se vuelve más oscura. Dios es amor y él tiene el control.
