Speaker: Luke Johanni, LGPC, NCC is a Catholic mental health therapist and founder of Restored Christian Counseling in Southern Maryland. He provides evidence-base therapy that unites psychology and faith to help individuals, couples, and families find healing and restoration.

Luke holds a Master's in Clinical Mental Health Counseling from Liberty University and is trained in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT), and the Gottman Method for Couples. His work focuses on anxiety, depression, grief, scrupulosity, men's mental health, sexual addictions, and couple relationships.

As a husband, father, and Catholic, Luke is passionate about helping others discover peace and purpose through Christ's healing power and addressing the whole person: body, mind, and soul. He also hosts the “Mind and Spirit” podcast, where he explores how faith and psychology work together to restore the human heart."

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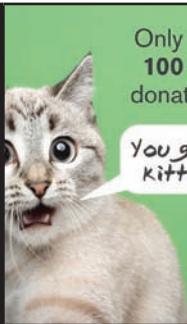
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
