#### **Duffy's Pantry**

During our August Parish Food Drive,
St. Patrick Parishioners and the
Our Lady of Hope Apostolate donated 2,046 pounds of
dry goods. \$172 in cash and checks were also donated.
\$133 was spent on trash bags, toilet paper, dish soap, foil,
detergent, cooking oil, broth, and vinegar.

Additionally, 4,246 pounds of meat, produce, deli, and bakery items were donated by the Food Lion in Locust Grove. The hens at St. Brigid's farm donated 123.5 dozen fresh eggs to the pantry! (That's 1,482 eggs!)

Thanks to your generosity, 80 households received food assistance.
